Parents for Megan's Law/Sex Offender Notification

Recent revisions to the New York State Corrections Law have expanded the availability of sex offender information. Law enforcement agencies can now provide community notifications regarding Level 1 offenders to include names, photographs, residing zip code, offense description and special probation and parole conditions.

We recently received notification of a Level 2 sex offender residing in the Islip Terrace/East Islip zip code area. You may access this information at:

As a reminder, in order to provide staff, parents/guardians, and residents with information concerning sex offenders who are living or working in the district, the East Islip School District uses an automated system for sex offender notifications. The New York State Division of Criminal Justice Sex Offender Relocation and E-mail Alert System will email district residents, who have registered, informing them of sex offenders who reside in their zip code area and direct them to their website where they can access a full copy of the notification.

To register to be placed on the E-mail list for notifications, residents may go to the District's website at www.eischools.org, click on the "Community" tab, then click on the "Sex Offender Notifications" link.
