Summary:

The West Hartford Police Department responded to a motor vehicle accident on South Quaker Lane in the area of Nutmeg Court.

Details:

On 9/2/26 at approximately 1234 hours, West Hartford Police, Fire and AMR medical services were dispatched to a roll over motor vehicle accident with electrical wires down as a result of a utility pole snapped in half.

Upon arrival, it was determined that a cyclist had also been struck during the course of the vehicle colliding with the telephone pole.

The vehicle operator, an adult male, was transported to the hospital with non-life-threatening injuries.

South Quaker Lane remains closed between Carol Rd. and Talcott Rd. while utility repairs are made.

The West Hartford Police Department's Traffic Division is actively investigating the incident.
