FINANCIAL AID

FAFSA/Dream Act:

Beginning in October, all VOHS students will apply for financial aid for college/trade school programs for after high school. We will complete the FAFSA (Free Application For Student Aid) or the Dream Act.

What is FAFSA?

- FAFSA = Free Application for Federal Student Aid.
- It's a form that decides how much financial aid (grants, work study, loans) you can get for college or trade school.

Why fill it out?

- Needed for Pell Grants, Cal Grants, scholarships, and tuition-free community college (like Delta).
- Most VOHS students qualify for free money to pursue education/training if they complete it.
- Completion = **graduation requirement** in California.

What will I need to complete the FAFSA or the Dream Act?

- In order to complete the first steps of the application, every student will need to know their Social Security Number (*if a student doesn't have a Social Security Number issued to them, we will follow up with them about the Dream Act Application).
- They will eventually need access to your 2025 tax/income information for the application as well.

This year, 58 VOHS students are enrolled in college level courses at San Joaquin Delta College, allowing them to earn transferable college credits while simultaneously fulfilling high school graduation requirements.

For the first time ever, Delta College professors come to our campus 2x per week to instruct students. The other days, students are in a supported class to ensure they are completing all requirements for the course.
