11 → 7 ones + 4 ones = 11 ones, or 1 ten + 1 one
50 → 5 tens + 0 tens = 5 tens
1,400 → 6 hundreds + 8 hundreds = 14 hundreds, or 1 thousand + 4 hundreds
+ 8,000 → 5 thousands + 3 thousands = 8 thousands
