TOOLS TO ENHANCE STUDENT SUCCESS



ORGANIZATION IS KEY

- Make a checklist of items needed to take to school every day. This includes textbooks, library books, IDs, paper, AVID binder or notebook, and pencils. Pack backpacks at night to ensure all items are accounted for and are ready for school the next morning.
- Organize and study all classroom notes 15–20 minutes daily.



TIME MANAGEMENT

- Write assignments in a monthly calendar, agenda, or notebook.
- Check off each item as it is completed to show progress.
- Work multiple days to break large assignments into smaller tasks.
