Superintendent Update

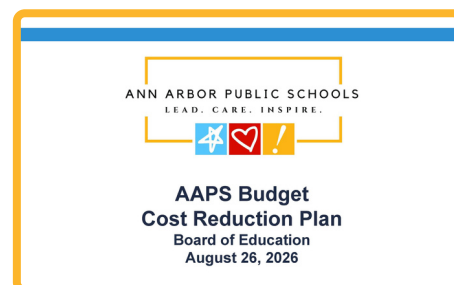
