Quick Lessons on the Mass

Then, the Priest dismisses the people, sending them forth saying, “Go forth, the Mass is ended,” or similar words. In Latin, the dismissal is *Ite missa est* which literally translates to, “Go, you are dismissed.” The word *missa* is where the word Mass comes from. Thus, the Mass truly is the source and summit of our faith. We have climbed to the summit, the highest moment of our Christian lives which we experience in this Eucharistic celebration and from this summit where we are fed with the Body and Blood of Christ, we are sent forth into the world as daily followers of Christ to “announce the Gospel of the Lord” and to “glorify the Lord by [our] lives”. Living daily in that peace and fraternal charity found solely in Christ Himself, we return to “doing good works, praising and blessing God” (GIRM, 90c).

Having venerated the altar, the Priest with the other ministers, go forth in the exit procession accompanied by the closing hymn.

For over forty years, St. Monica Friends of the Needy (FON) has been feeding the homeless. FON began in the early 1980s by delivering a hot meal every Tuesday to St. Martin de Porres Shelter in Seattle. As the number of homeless has risen in the Seattle area, FON has worked to keep pace. As this ministry continues to grow and evolve, its daily work maintains a focus on FON's founding objective, "To feed those in need!" FON is open to all (non-denominational). Do you have a calling from God to join us? We are looking for men and women that would love to serve those in need in the Seattle and Bellevue area. FON currently serves six shelters with a hot meal every Tuesday evening and delivers food to eight different Food banks in the Seattle eastside area.

How Can I Serve and What Is The Commitment?

Van drivers pick up food from local retailers (Met Market and Einsteins Bagels) Monday-Sunday.

- Deliver food to St. Monica's and to several Food banks in our area.
- Time Commitment, 2 hours once a month.

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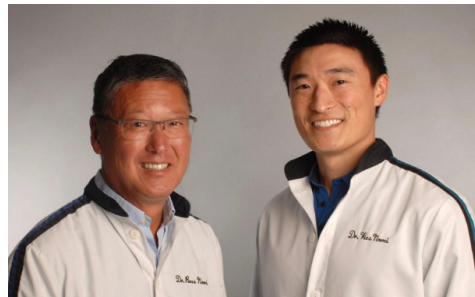
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
