Discussion Item: Introduce Members

Discussion Item: Council Meeting Dates 2026-2027 SY

- A. The council discussed scheduling this school years meetings. The council discussed moving the meetings to the morning. The council determined meetings to be held once a month on Thursday mornings at 7:15am. The following dates were determined 8/27, 9/17, 10/22, 11/19, 12/9, 1/21, 2/25, 3/18, and 4/29. These meetings dates are subject to change.

Discussion Item: Council Beginning of Year Initiatives (Attendance)

- A. The council discussed attendance as a continued initiative for this school year. We discussed that we still have some games and toys to do a raffle at open house. Mrs. Alhadeff shared how open house will run this year. It will take place on July 31st from 9-12:15 with K-2nd grade first and then 3rd-5th after. The council discussed ways to ensure parent involvement with take home activities. Mrs. Dill shared ideas about QR codes for surveys to measure parent involvement. The council discussed making a sign at open house and kicking off the first month with an attendance challenge to increase attendance during the 10 day count especially to ensure staffing needs. The challenge will run from 8/4-8/31 with a bounce house at the end for those with no absences. The council discussed incentives for parents. The past year gift cards for some restaurants were not always used with our population. The council also planned the second attendance incentive to run from 9/1-10/9 and will have the attendance wheel at the PTO Fall Bash/Fun Run. The next will run from 10/13-12/4 to spin the wheel at the holiday feast.

Discussion Item: Charter Dollar Expenditure

- A. The council discussed charter dollars expenditure. The council discussed that the council has funded personnel in the past. The dollars would cover a .3 teacher. Mrs. Alhadeff shared that multiple grades are at their max to earn a 3rd teacher, but it is possible they do not. Therefore, class sizes would be larger and extra help would be beneficial. The council discussed other options and determined personnel would be the most beneficial. Voting will take place at the next meeting.

Informational Item: Principals Update

- A. Mrs. Alhadeff shared academic data results from last school year. Overall, our students made great growth. Skills groups have really help target student needs. Our CCRPI score is 84.6! This is a huge increase from 60.1 in 2023. Vickery Mill was recognized as a "Beating the Odds" school, School Cleanliness Award, and is a PBIS Distinguished school. Mrs. Alhadeff has been recognized with an Communication Award for always sharing Vickery Mill happenings with our community. She also shared about our ArtsNow Integration Grant. Vickery Mill now has a 4 year Federal Grant.
