Traffic Safety Notice for 2026 Calvert Co. Fair

For safety purposes, a special traffic pattern will be in effect from 10 am to 10 pm on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday of Fair Week. No vehicles will be allowed to turn left off of Rt 231 into the Fairgrounds during those hours. An alternate route would be to use Rt. 506 (Sixes Road) to Rt. 508 (Adelina Road) to Rt. 231 which will allow a Right Turn into the Fairgrounds.

Once the Fairground Parking lots are full, Satellite Parking will be available at the College of Southern Maryland. Free Shuttle Bus Service will be available from CSM.

Additionally, once the parking lot is full, there will be an entrance for Vendors **(If space is available)** and Drop-off/Pick-up. This drop off will be the dirt-road past the main entrance. There will be a sign posted at this entrance. Drop-off/Pick-up will turn in and turn immediately to the right. Once drop-off/pick-up has been completed, cars will be directed to exit the grounds. Vendors must have a pass to be admitted or will be directed to exit the grounds.

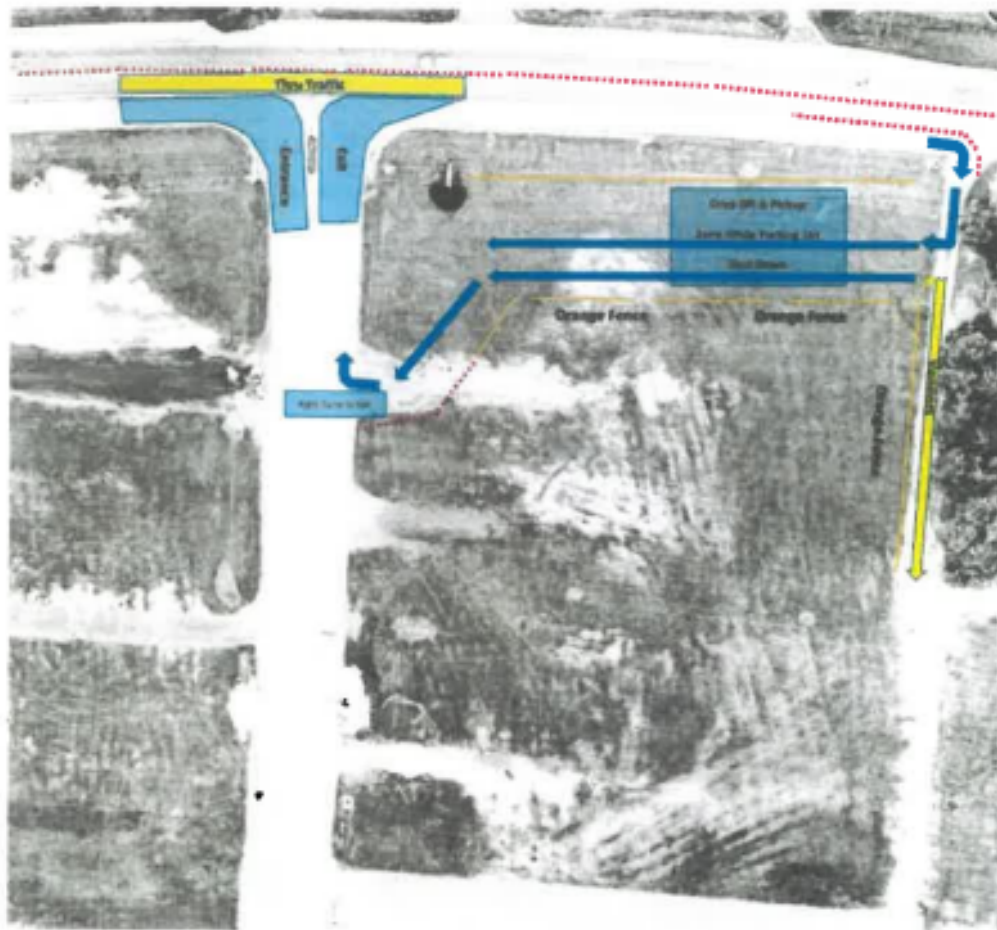
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
