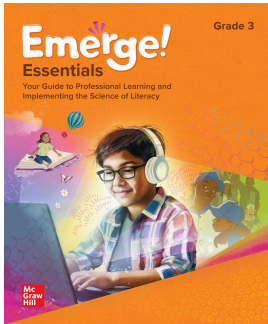

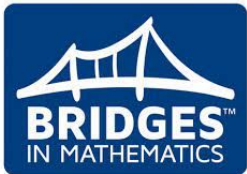
English Language Arts

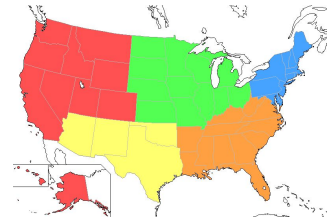
