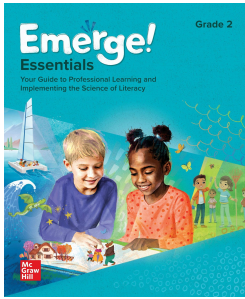

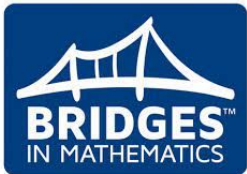
English Language Arts
