Tier 1: Education

Students who violate the requirements may be referred to a diversion program

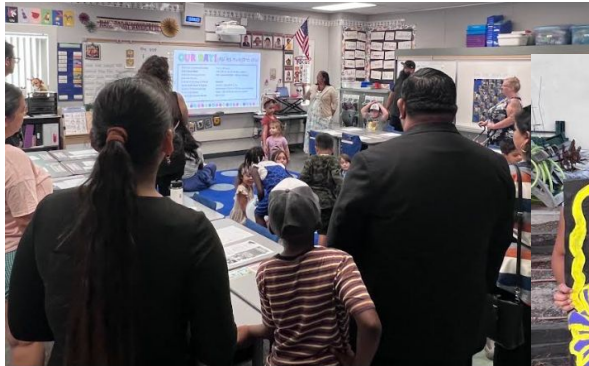
