



EXPLORATION EXPERIENCE 2026-2027 AFTER SCHOOL Expanded Learning



What?

An exciting, no-cost opportunity for students in grades TK-8 to explore and engage in hands-on learning through Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Math (STEAM). The program also includes physical education, homework support, and may offer occasional off-site learning experiences.

Who?

In alignment with state funding requirements, priority enrollment is first provided to TK-6 students who are experiencing homelessness or in foster care, English learners, and low-income households. Once priority placements are filled, additional students will be considered based on remaining space.

Why?

These experiences help to broaden students' academic skills and knowledge as well as the social and emotional capacity to use their skills and knowledge competently and compassionately in life.

When?

Begins immediately after school and ends at 6:00 PM each day (including minimum days).

Note: End time at the following schools:

5:00 PM at Crafton, Highland Grove, and Mission.

6:00 PM at Beattie, Clement, Cope and Moore
