The Talented Arts Program provides specialized instruction for students who demonstrate exceptional ability in **art**, **music**, or **theatre**. Students in grades K-12 who meet Louisiana Department of Education eligibility criteria may qualify for services.



Parents interested in having their child screened should contact **Haley Saweikis (School SBLC Contact)**, or have your student visit Student Services, to request a screening packet and complete the required **Talented Screening Permission and Documentation Form**.

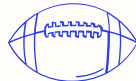

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FAQs

Why should I purchase Chromebook Insurance?

- Students will be using their Chromebooks daily and accidents will happen. The cost of the Chromebook Insurance is much cheaper than the cost of fixing a Chromebook.

What is the cost of the Chromebook Insurance?

- The price for the 2026/2027 school year is \$25.00. This can be paid by using MyPaymentsPlus.

What is Cane Cash Thursdays?

- Once a month, students can redeem their Cane Cash for snacks and/or treats during their lunch.

What is PTA Smoothie/Moo Moo day?

- Once a month, students can purchase a Smoothie or Moo Moo, depending on the month, at lunch. Please look for the pre-purchase forms in the first day packets if you would like to order in advance for the entire year.

What is the "ADV/LIM" class on the students' schedules?

- This is a 20 minute daily class in which students will take part in Leader In Me lessons as well as enrichment lessons. Monday will be "Be Proactive Monday" for student organizational purposes. Tuesday will be Math enrichment, Wednesday will be a Leader In Me lesson, Thursday will be ELA enrichment, and Friday will be a day that will vary weekly.

How does carline work?

- Everyone will enter using the main entrance, Hurricane Alley, for both morning and afternoon carline. Barricades and cones will be set up for you as you work your way through the faculty parking lot to the gym.

What is a spirit shirt? When can they be worn?
