Subject: Important Update Regarding Unsolicited Food at RSU #22

Dear Parents and Guardians,

The health, safety, and well-being of our students is our top priority. We are writing to inform you that, according to the RSU #22 Wellness Regulation, we will "Not allow unsolicited food for children in the schools during the school day".

In order to maintain a safe environment for students with severe food allergies and to ensure equitable practices during celebrations, we will be adhering to this "no outside food" rule for all classrooms and school events.

Going forward, please adhere to the following guidelines:

- No Outside Food: Only snacks and home lunches for your student are permissible.
- No Homemade Treats: Homemade cakes, cupcakes, or baked goods are no longer permitted to be brought in and shared with the class.
- Celebrations and Birthdays: If you would like to celebrate your child's birthday or a special milestone, please consider non-food alternatives such as donating a book to the classroom library, handing out stickers, or bringing in pencils.

Please note that this policy helps us protect children with life-threatening allergies and ensures that all students are included equally in classroom activities.

If your child has specific dietary restrictions, medical conditions, or requires accommodations, please contact the school nurse or main office so we can make the necessary arrangements.

Thank you for your understanding, cooperation, and partnership in keeping our school a safe and healthy place to learn.

Arrival

The doors are open to students beginning at 8:30 a.m. All students will say their goodbyes and then enter the school's front entrance and report to their classrooms on the first day.

Students in Pre-K and Kindergarten will arrive and enter the school through the front entrance every day. There will be many staff members available to help students to their classrooms.

First graders will begin their day either at breakfast or on the playground beginning on the second day of school.

Dismissal

Students will be dismissed from their classroom's exterior or designated door. Your child's teacher will help you locate the appropriate door during your Open House visit. Dismissal will begin at 3:00. Bus dismissal will begin shortly after.

Please email the school office at mcgrawoffice@rsu22.us with any changes to after school destination and travel plans BEFORE 2:00 p.m. to ensure we receive the information and can communicate to your child's teacher. Afternoons are very busy in the office, so advanced notice of changes from parents is most helpful.

Bus Information

If your child will be riding the bus, please ensure you have completed the appropriate bus paperwork. Cyr bus company can provide families with a more specific time frame that you can expect your student to be picked up and/or dropped off at home. It's always best to be outside a few minutes early. Please also keep in mind that our youngest learners are just beginning their journey on the bus, therefore buses may be slightly delayed the first few days until we all become more efficient with the procedures at dismissal.

Bus Routes/Numbers

Hampden Pre-K-5 students have the same bus number in the morning as they do in the afternoon.

Starts at 6:40 from the corner of Meadow Road and Route 69 headed towards Kennebec Road, end of Piper Woods Road, right on Rae Way, to the Hampden/Winterport town line on Route 69, end of Hampden Woods Road, left on Kennebec Road to Newburgh town line, including end of Merchant Road from Box 1420 Kennebec Road to Box 208, turn right on Emerald Drive, right on Wessnette Drive, right on Monroe Road to town line, right on Norway Drive, right on Pine Grove Drive, end of Libby Lane, drop students at Weatherbee, drop students at McGraw.

Run #3

Starts at 7:45 at the corner of Route 202 and Coldbrook Road to Hermon town line, including Old Coldbrook Road, left on Coldbrook Road from Route 202, right on Emerson Drive, right on Ruth Avenue, right on Jay Way, end of Cool Brook Lane, left on Lindsey Way, right on Papermill Road, left on Emerson Mill Road, left on Ledgewood Drive, right on Manning Mill Road, end of Old Emerson Mill Road South. Left onto Western Avenue, from Box 358 to Box 1 right on Hughes Boulevard, right on Town Farm Road, right on Country Meadow Drive, left on Griffin Avenue, end of Jewel Drive, left on Sidney Boulevard, right on Wilbur Drive, left on Evergreen Drive, left on Surrey Lane, right on Constitution Avenue, left on Independence Avenue, right on Liberty Avenue, left on Freedom Avenue, drop students at Weatherbee, drop students at McGraw.

Run #2

Start at 7:50 at Mountainview Drive, left on Main Road North, left on Hillside Drive (including end of Summit Drive), end of Future Way, end of Marina Road, left Schoolhouse Lane, right on Old County Road, left on Triangle Road (including end of Triangle Drive), right on Main Road North, end of Hunting Lane, end of Kelly Lane, right on Schoolhouse Lane, left on Old County Road, right on Hamel, left on Northern Avenue, left on Wheelden Heights, right on Patterson Street, left on Perry Road, left on Coolidge Avenue, right on Ballfield Road, drop students at Weatherbee, drop students at McGraw.

Run #6

Starts at 7:50 on Patterson Road, left on Meadow Road, left on Ichabod Lane, right on Graystone Drive, right on Route 69 from Meadow Road to the intersection blinking light in Newburgh, including end of Babcock Lane, left on Butternut Lane, left on Acorn Drive, right on Route 9 Western Avenue Hampden town line to Box 1102, drop students at Weatherbee, drop students at McGraw.

Run #8

Starts at 7:50 Back Winterport Road from Baker Road, right on Kennebec Road Box 206 to 1, right on Main Road South 1A Box 1 to Winterport town line and Main road North Box 1 to 16, right on Highland Ridge Drive, right on Foster Avenue, right on Rawley Drive, right on Clark Circle, right on Perkins Road, end of Kincaid Road, right on Hopkins Road, right on Pleasant Street, left on Cross Street, left on Summer Street, end of Ferry Street, end of Swan Avenue, end of Orient Avenue, drop students at Weatherbee, drop students at McGraw.

Run #5

Starts at 7:35 Route 9 from Hughes Blvd. to Sawyer Road Box 372 to Box 1088, including left on Bowen Drive, left on John's Way, right on Dunton Circle, right on Silver Drift Lane, left on Aarons Way, end of Goodell Farm Road, left on Sawyer Road, left on Canaan Road, drop students at Weatherbee, drop students at McGraw.

Run #4

Starts at 7:35 Deer Hill Lane, left on Shaw Hill Road, right on Stetson Drive, right on Miller Road, left on Fowler Road, right on Shaw Hill Road, right on Bog Road to town line, right on Pond Road, right on North County Road to town line, right on Shaw Hill Road, right on Mayo Road, drop students at Weatherbee, drop students at McGraw.

Run #1

Starts at 7:50 at Main Trail, left on Coldbrook Road, right on Laskey Lane, left on Main Road North Box 34 to Box 440, left on Stearns Farm Road, right on Briggs Drive, end of Adams Way left on Daisey Lane, left on Horseshoe Lane, left on Charles Street to Edgewood Drive, left on Stoneybrook Road, left on Linden Street, right on Williams Street, right on George Street, left on Sunset Avenue, right on Westbrook Terrace, left on Chickadee Lane, right on Sunrise Avenue, end of Carver Road, right on Riverview Road, left on Marion Drive, left on Francis Drive, left on Sophie Lane, left on Carriage Lane, end of Dudley Street (including Short Wharf Road), end of Elm Street West, end of Elm Street East, left on Cottage Street, left on VFW Road, end of Rowell Road, left on Cottage Street, drop students at Weatherbee, drop students at McGraw.

Drop students at Weatherbee, drop students at McGraw.

Run #10

Starts at 7:40 on Lindsay Road (Route 9 Western Avenue end), end of Bates Road, left on North Road to Box 1223, end of Kenniston Road, straight on North County Road, left on Route 69 to intersection of the blinking light on Route 69 and Route 9. Drop students at Weatherbee, drop students at McGraw.

Run #11

Starts at 7:30 on Mudget Road (Kennebec Road end), end of Frank West Road, end of Croxford Road, left on Route 9, end of Thurlow Road, right on Miles Road, end of Red School House Road, right on Route 9, to Dixmont town line, end of Kennard Road, making a stop at Newburgh School and all of Route 9 to Hampden line. Drop students at Weatherbee, drop students at McGraw.

Attention parents of Newburgh students:

Newburgh students who live on
Route 69 from Route 9 to the top
of the hill to the Hampden town
line will take Bus #6.

Parent Volunteer Training

We are so fortunate here at McGraw to have parent volunteers to support many parts of our day and programming. We welcome helpers for our recess and lunches, field trips, and special days (WinterFest and Field Day). We will advertise these and additional opportunities throughout the

Health Tips and Information from Nurse Adams

Dear McGraw Families,



It has been so nice having all of your children back at school! As we move further into September (and cold/flu season), I wanted to remind you of our district health/wellness policies. Also, if you have not yet returned your child's health update form, please do so as soon as possible.

Dental Health

-Please return all dental health forms by Friday, September 11. These forms only need to be completed

And returned if you wish for your child to participate

Medications

-All medications must be administered through the health office and have signed consent by a parent/guardian

- Long-term (greater than 3 weeks) medications must have a signed permit by a parent/guardian and a healthcare provider.

-Medications must be hand delivered to the office by a parent/guardian. Please do not send them in your child's backpack.

-Cough drops and cough lollipops are not allowed at McGraw.

Illnesses

-If your child is ill with a fever or has gastrointestinal symptoms (vomiting and/or diarrhea), they must be symptom free for 24 hours without the use of symptom-reducing medication for 24 hours- this also includes if your child is sent home with these symptoms. They must remain home from school the next day.

-If your child tests positive for covid, influenza, RSV, etc, they must remain fever free from 24 hours with improving symptoms for 24 hours without the use of symptom-reducing medications

-If your child is ill with a contagious bacterial illness, such as strep throat or conjunctivitis, they

must be on antibiotics for 12 hours prior to returning to school. For other bacterial illnesses, such as hand, foot, and mouth, please contact me via phone or email for guidance.

Fall is here but the weather is still nice! Here are a few tips to help keep your children safe and comfortable at school:

Sunscreen and Insect Repellent

-We are not able to apply sunscreen or insect repellent to students during the school day. If you wish for your student to wear these items, please apply them in the morning prior to sending them to school.

Dressing for the Weather

-This time of year the mornings tend to be cool and the afternoons warmer. It is best to dress your child in clothing appropriate for warmer weather and add layers. You may also send a change of clothes in your child's backpack. We all know how unpredictable Maine weather can be.

-Please send your child to school in proper footwear for running and playing outside. Sneakers are preferred for safety reasons.

-An extra set of clothes in their backpacks is always a good idea too! Accidents and spills happen!

Ticks

-Ticks are most active during the warmer months (April- September), and it's important to take precautions to protect yourself and your family from potential tick bites and the diseases they can transmit.
