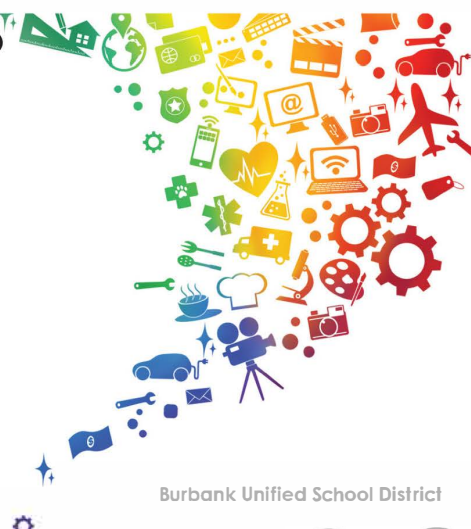

Important Information:

- Students with accommodations, please see the posted procedural information at www.cte.burbankusd.org under Dual Enrollment.
- Schedule subject to change, courses subject to cancellation if minimum enrollment not met. Classes are full once maximum enrollment is reached.
- Courses are for elective credit only, **exception:** LAVC's Cinema 105 and Cinema 107 fulfills either 10 Fine Art credits for high school OR elective credits.
- ENROLLMENT/WAIT LISTED ENROLLMENT, DROP and WITHDRAWAL** procedures are the student's responsibility.
- Students that withdraw from their CTE dual enrollment class will have Withdrawal Fail (WF) posted on their HS transcript and Withdrawal (W) on their college transcript for the final grade.**
- WAIT LISTED students are not guaranteed placement in a class.
- Students **MUST** be enrolled prior to first class, have access to Canvas, attend the first class, and regularly be active on Canvas to not be dropped by the professor. **Exception:** Students who are not enrolled by the first class **MUST** email the professor for permission to join the class while completing their enrollment.
- Students can be enrolled in a maximum of 40 credits per semester.
- Only 1 CTE dual enrollment class per student.
- Students must have a 2.0 (overall 9-12th grade) GPA to participate in dual enrollment.
- Dual Enrollment grades are not weighted like a high school AP course.
- Make sure to enroll into the correct dual enrollment class number and follow the start/end dates and times listed. **Not the times listed on the Aeries Student Portal.**
