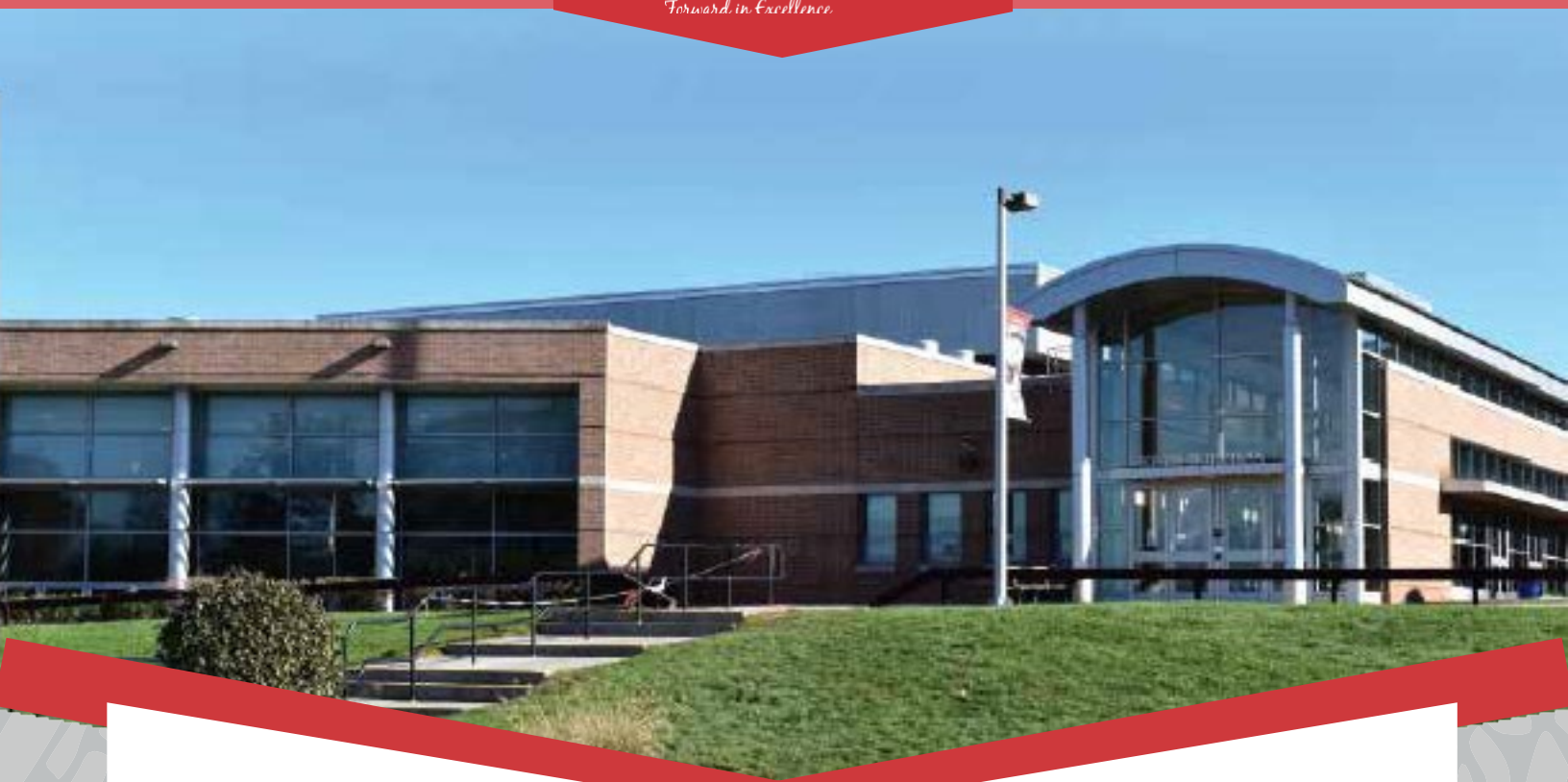


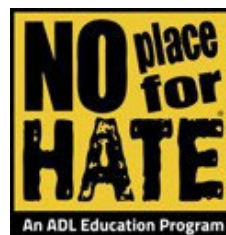


## SCHOOL

Recognized by the **US Department of Education as a National Blue Ribbon School of Excellence and certified as an IB World School**, Somers High School offers students a wide range of academic, extra-curricular, and transitional opportunities. 100% of teaching faculty and administration hold either a Masters Degree or Doctorate in their respective discipline. Central to our educational mission in Somers are the cultivation of 21st Century knowledge and skills, social-emotional and physical wellness, and global citizenship.

## COMMUNITY

Somers is a residential, suburban community of approximately 20,000 persons located in northern Westchester County, 45 miles from New York City. The school district Town of Somers includes the hamlets of Lincolndale, Shenorock, Granite Springs, Purdys, Baldwin Place and Amawalk. A large percentage of the residents commute to jobs in southern Westchester and New York City. ## ACCREDITATION

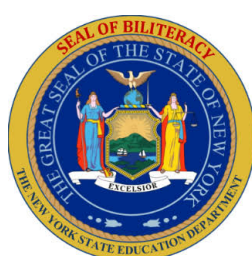

# GRADING POLICY

2026-2027

Grades earned through June 2026 are reported on a 0-100 scale. Beginning September 2026, grades will be reported on a A-F scale. Grade range: A+= 97-100, A= 93-96, A-=90-92, B+= 87-89, B= 83-86, B-=80-82, C+= 77-79, C= 73-76, C-= 70-72, D+= 67-69, D= 65-66, F= 0-64. Passing grade is D (65) or above.

**TRANSCRIPT:** Transcripts reflect all grades earned at Somers HS, as well as transfer and credit recovery grades. Credit Recovery and approved courses taken online are recorded as P/F. Both a weighted and unweighted GPA is calculated.

**WEIGHTING:** On the 100-pt scale, AP and IB courses receive an additional 6 points and Honors and DE courses receive an additional 3 points within the cumulative GPA calculation (not in the transcript final average). All subjects except courses graded P/F or listed as IS (Independent Study) are included in the GPA calculation.

## INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE INFORMATION

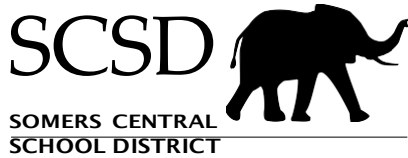

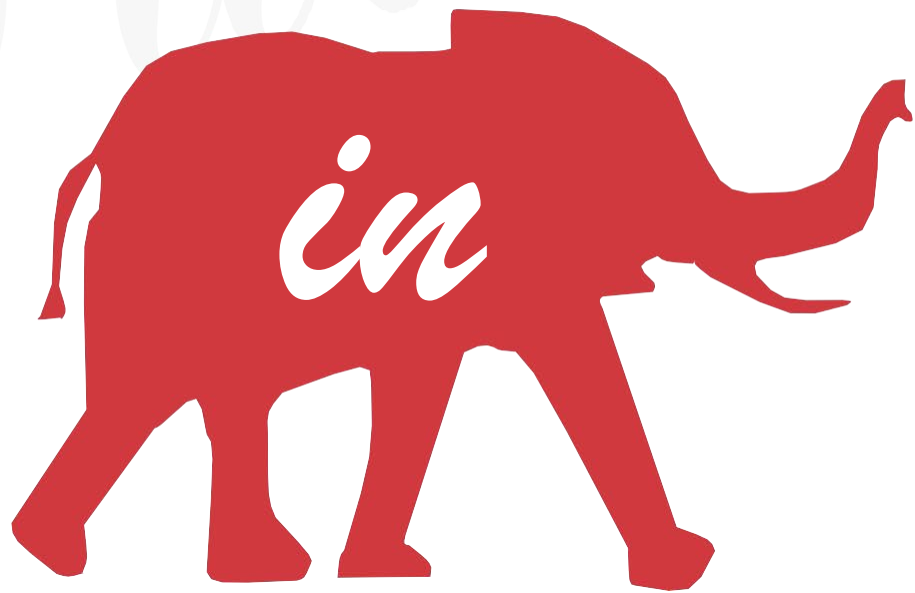
