Vestibule Info. During School Hours

Please follow our drop-off and pick-up procedure to help increase school safety and simplicity for families.

- **Item Drop-Off:**
Families should leave all items to be dropped off in the middle school lobby entrance. Shelves are labeled by grade level for easy organization. Larger items may be placed on the table outside the front office.
- **Student Pick-Up for Appointments:**
If you need to pick up your child during the school day, please notify the front office in advance by emailing wmsattendance@wyomingcityschools.org or calling 513-206-7181. Your child will be ready and waiting when you arrive. Please wait in the vestibule for pick-up.
- **Student Pick-Up at the Nurse:**
If your child becomes ill during the school day, the nurse will contact families directly. We will ensure your child is ready in the front office when you arrive. Please wait in the vestibule for pick-up.
