

STUDENT IDENTIFICATION BADGE EXPECTATIONS

AFTER-SCHOOL EVENTS & ACTIVITIES



STUDENT ID BADGES REQUIRED FOR ENTRY

To help ensure a safe, secure, and welcoming environment, FWISD students are required to present a current school-issued Student ID badge when attending district-sponsored after-school events.



EVENTS COVERED

-  Athletic Events
-  Fine Arts Performances
-  School Dances
-  Academic Competitions
-  After-School Pep Rallies
-  School-Sponsored Extracurricular Activities
-  Any District-Sponsored Event Where Student Admission Is Permitted



STUDENT EXPECTATIONS

-  Present a valid FWISD Student ID upon entry.
-  Keep your Student ID available if requested by campus staff or Safety & Security.
-  Use only your assigned Student ID.
-  Follow all event expectations and the Student Code of Conduct.

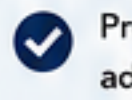
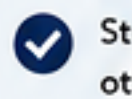
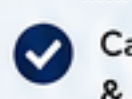


WHY STUDENT IDs MATTER

-  Verify authorized attendees.
-  Support emergency response and reunification.
-  Improve campus safety and accountability.
-  Reduce unauthorized access to school events.



HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

-  Present a valid FWISD Student ID for admission to extracurricular activities, including stadium events.
-  Students attending from campuses other than the participating home or visitor school must sit in the designated visitor seating area or with a parent/responsible adult, as directed by event staff.
-  Campus administrators and Safety & Security personnel will monitor seating areas to maintain a safe event environment.



MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENTS



Middle school students must be accompanied by a parent or responsible adult to gain admission to all district stadium events.

Unaccompanied middle school students will not be admitted.



STUDENTS FROM OTHER DISTRICTS



Students from another school district must present a valid school-issued ID or be accompanied by a parent or responsible adult.

Visiting students will be directed to the visitor seating area.



ELEMENTARY STUDENTS



Elementary-aged students should be accompanied by a parent or responsible adult unless attending as part of a school-sponsored activity under district supervision.

ADDITIONAL EVENT EXPECTATIONS



RE-ENTRY

Students who leave an event may not be permitted to re-enter unless approved by the Event Administrator.



NON-COMPLIANCE

Failure to comply with event expectations may result in denial of entry or removal from the event in accordance with the Student Code of Conduct.



ADMINISTRATOR DISCRETION

The Event Administrator may make reasonable exceptions in emergency or verified circumstances.
