Students with a PLAY Card can check out up to 5 physical items from a PINES library at a time, including books, DVDs, CDs, free passes to state parks, and more.

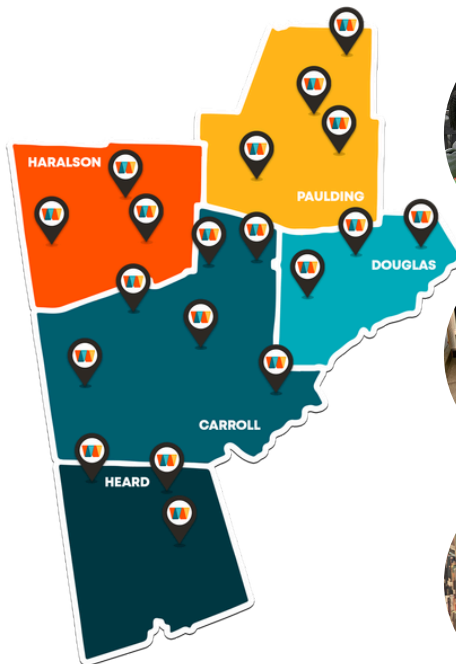
The PLAY Card will also give your student free access to digital resources such as e-books through Libby and Palace Project, language learning through Mango Languages, practice tests for SAT, ACT, nursing entrance exams, and more through Galileo.

## What if you don't want your child to have a PLAY Card?

If you would prefer your student to not have a PLAY Card, you may opt out of this program by notifying your school district.

**Checkout free e-books and audiobooks on Libby. Limited to 10 items at a time.**



**The Palace Project app has free e-books and audiobooks as well as access to the eRead Kids database.**



**Stream free e-books, e-audiobooks, comics, movies, TV shows, and music on Hoopla. Limited to 4 per month. (Starts over on 1<sup>st</sup> of every month.)**



**Stream free movies on Kanopy. Limited to 12 tickets per month**

## How does it work?

- Students enrolled with Paulding County Schools (Kindergarten - 12th grade) will have access to their PLAY Card.
  - *12th graders will have access to their PLAY Cards until October 15<sup>th</sup> after graduation.*
- Your PLAY card number is **PAU**lunchnumber.
  - \*PAU must be all caps when signing into the PINES database and apps that require a library card number.
- Your default password is your birthday in 6 digits that follows the (MMYYYY) format.
  - *Students may change their password via the PINES website after logging in with the birthday as the password. The website is [gapines.org](http://gapines.org)*
    - Click MY ACCOUNT in the upper right corner
    - Sign in
    - Click PREFERNECES>PERSONSONAL INFORMATION on left
    - Then CHANGE PASSWORD on right
- The PLAY Card is free and access to public library resources and services are free.
