HAVE YOUR ASSOCIATE DEGREE?

Offered for aspiring elementary or special education teachers.

Earn a Bachelor's degree from VCU

2 years (including summers) of online VCU courses - cost of tuition covered

Spend 2 full academic years in a K-12 classroom learning from a rockstar teacher (Y1: T, W, Th and Y2: M-Th)

Gradually take on more teaching responsibilities over the course of the two years.

Commit to teaching in the district for 3 years following graduation at a high-need school

You must have:

- A 2.5 cumulative GPA
- One of the following associate degrees from a regionally accredited institution: Associate of Arts, Associate of Science, Associate of Arts & Science, Associate of Fine Arts, Certificate of General Studies, General Education Certificate, and Associate of Applied Sciences in Early Childhood Development

HAVE YOUR BACHELOR'S DEGREE?

Offered for aspiring elementary, special education, English, math, science, or social studies teachers.

Earn a master's degree or graduate certificate

1 year (summer, fall, spring) of VCU courses - cost of tuition covered

Spend a full academic year in a K-12 classroom working alongside a mentor Monday through Thursday

Gradually take on more teaching responsibilities over the course of the year

Commit to teaching in the district for 3 years following graduation at a high-need school

You must have:

- A 3.0 cumulative GPA
- A bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited institution
