What I Learn in PE Class

Every day your physical education teacher uses the **National Standards for K-12 Physical Education** to help you become a physically literate person. Being physically literate is a fancy way of saying that you know how to be physically active and that you enjoy being physically active. Learning to be physically literate in physical education class now will help you continue to be healthy and active when you grow up.

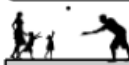
Look at the **National Standards** to help you understand what you are learning in PE.

A physically literate individual:	What this means to me:
1 demonstrates competency in a variety of motor skills and movement patterns.	I have the skills to move and play.
2 applies knowledge of concepts, principles, strategies and tactics related to movement and performance.	I show that I know how to move and use a plan when I play games.
3 demonstrates the knowledge and skills to achieve and maintain a health-enhancing level of physical activity and fitness.	I show that I know how to get fit and stay fit.
4 exhibits responsible personal and social behavior that respects self and others.	I act fairly and respectfully when I play.
5 recognizes the value of physical activity for health, enjoyment, challenge, self-expression and/or social interaction.	I know why it is important to be physically active.

BUS INFORMATION

IMPORTANT REMINDERS



Bus passes/schedules will be available when Genesis opens. Please continue checking your child's bus pass up until the night before school starts for possible changes.



The bus will stop approximately **10 feet** from the students. Students should wait until the bus is fully stopped and then walk single file to the bus doors.



If crossing the street, look both ways and make sure the bus is fully stopped with its **red flashing lights** activated before crossing.



Always cross in front of the bus, **never** behind it.



If something is dropped while getting on or off the bus, **do not bend down to pick it up** while the bus is there. Alert the driver, as the driver may not be able to see you.



Please be respectful of other people's property while waiting at the bus stop.



No eating or drinking on the bus.



Cell phones should remain put away while on the bus.

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Information about Excused/Unexcused Absences



Attendance Matters

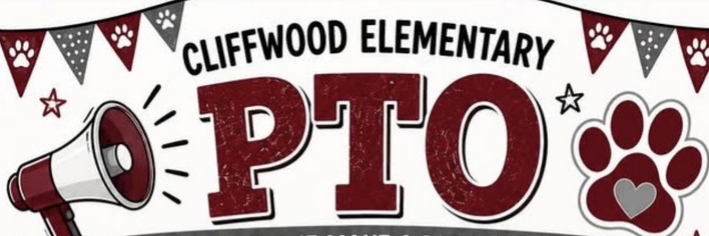
Every student. Every day.

The New Jersey Department of Education recognizes only six allowable reasons for an "excused" absence; these reasons are listed below.

1. Religious holidays (Each year, the State Board of Education votes on a list of approved religious holidays for observance upon the written request signed by the parent.).
2. Participation in observance of Veterans Day.
3. Participation in district board of election membership activities.
4. Take Our Children to Work Day.
5. College visit(s), up to three days per school year for students in grades 11 and 12.
6. Closure of a busing school district that prevents a student from having transportation to the receiving school.

Being present and on-time to school each day is extremely important for students' success and well-being. School attendance is a powerful predictor of student outcomes; data shows that, when students are present daily, they learn better and are generally healthier. **Attendance matters and every school day counts!**

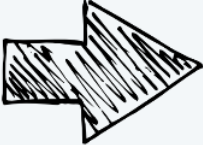
