The Monroe Career & Technical Institute, located in Bartonsville, Pennsylvania, provides education for students who reside in the following school districts: East Stroudsburg, Pleasant Valley, Pocono Mountain and Stroudsburg.

The Monroe Career & Technical Institute (MCTI) has been cooperatively planned and developed by representatives from business, education, labor and industry. The school is organized to supplement the educational program of all the high schools of Monroe County. Each pupil attends the appropriate high school of his or her home school district for a half-day and the MCTI for a half-day. Upon graduation, the student may receive a certificate of competency, list of skills obtained and industry recognized credentials, in addition to the diploma awarded by the home high school.

The MCTI has been developed to meet the present and future needs of students to enter the workforce and/or post-secondary education. The programs listed below are occupation areas in which a broad spectrum of specific trade, technical or service occupations exist.
