8:00 AM Discussion Item: Review Strategic Plan, VAF, Magnet Renewal (Scheifflee)

We will renew VAF; in September; VIF; extended lunch privilege; night school opportunities; not funded by district; take a look at scheduling; don't have an update; **Lawson**-no new plan; a multi-year plan voted in spring; **Scheifflee** look at graduation 98.4; look at goals; SGC; staff retention and satisfaction; relevant data; draw up a comparison; much of the verbiage; ask staff members; school district and central office; staff satisfaction; in relation to the district; rather than local; created a local; one matrix identified a growth area; were able to exceed; staff committee; staff incentive; staff engagement; rock; paper scissors; school wide; get teachers from other department; engage and interactive; a little bit more fun; competition; planning monthly; growth and positive; job satisfaction; recommend Alpharetta as a place to work; magnet; VAF; reverification process; significant; IB teachers and Mr. Fortunato; **Turner**-any question; **Hood**-time line; data from last year? **Scheifflee**; formalized and work toward; **Turner**- staff bucket; using survey data from district; one thing; survey to staff; basic feedback on how things were going; free responsive; MC; use AI; 3 areas; staff focused; parent runed; feedback; some negative; positive; conversation; collected data; a teacher walks in kind of cranky or parent; perinates; more opportunities to create positivity's; I'll be happy to share findings; **Hood**-please

8:10 AM Informational Item: Principal's Update (Scheifflee)

School store built this month; a day; 1 single source vendor to run merchandise; work with district; ease and continuity; extensive collection; anything he doesn't provide that we might want; he'll have access; work with SC; 9th grade well behave; 10th grade rambunctious; 11th indifferent; years past instructional videos; upper classmen not advisement; some student don't get; 9th and 10th thought they had permission to walk off campus; major concern; face to face meeting; off campus privilege; PBIS; café; SGA student ID wearing; some changes, every one is expected to wear Id; **Bailey**-are we still having students to scan and request ID if they need a hall pass and currently do not have an ID; **Scheifflee**; yes, they should also be given a pass to Media Center for a temporary student ID: IB and blended learning; students verifying attendance off campus; at some point this year, give ever scanner, scan as students in room; for attendance; initiative; don't necessarily have to wear; lanyard visible and accessible; pocket; bookbag; 4 periods a day, 5 days a week; attendance procedures upheld; ask for pass; cannot be in hall without a student Id; tying in privilege; helps us to identify who is in the hallway; who you are; hallways are colored codes; that's just going to help curtail wandering; maximizes instructional time; we did make announcement; 8:20-3:30 major upset for the junior class; policy makers and school board members; adaptation of state law; push; purchase lockers next year; as a way to discourage; I will say

all 3 class; I made explicated announcement; only saw 1 kid on phone; our students aren't liking it; but embracing; level of classmate; **Turner**; fully implemented at Webb Bridge; freshmen will be adjusted;

Scheifflee-temporary day pass; access to infinite campus; scannable id; class schedule; take a screenshot; day one print out schedule, pass out during 1st period

Hood-scanner; timeline? **Scheifflee** district or school pay? Decline will not be buying for pilot; technology is the factor; it is supposed to happen sometime next year; minimally impact; **Turner**-fine arts large classes; **Scheifflee**; if technology works properly the bottle neck won't be a concern

Hood-law; implementation? **Scheifflee**; leave at home; no teacher is collecting; classroom room to transition; and lunches;

Hood-magnetic bags; has been no instructions; **Scheifflee**; we've heard from bag venders; but focus on utilizing lockers

Ethridge-Henry county is using

Scheifflee-Raider Fest is September 30th; Wednesday after Fall break; Homecoming is October 3rd; ?? and Staff meetup; Enrollment below projections; No Shows; low numbers; Master schedule and student schedules may change; HVAC contractors were here every day; teacher classrooms were in great shape after repairs; AC works better this week compared last week; pockets of ice cold areas in the school; don't know we have to make summer because AHS getting new gym floors; Entire school flooring and lighting upgraded; school store hopefully will be operation by curriculum night; need to sort out payment systems; will be school cash or something else; apparel will be available during curriculum night; patio is significantly cleaner; AHS foundation spent \$18,000 to have refurbished (?) Next step is replacing wood tables to metal; SGC might be asked to provide funds to remodel this meeting room; Raider Fest is September 30th; Pep Rally is October 2nd and Dance is October 3rd
