Pumpkin Picking, Animal Experience and Wagon Ride- A tractor-drawn wagon ride to the pumpkin patch for a lesson on the pumpkin life cycle, then pick their favorite pumpkin to take home, meet and feed farm animals, explore crops, and see real farm equipment on a working farm.

Create your own Pumpkin Patch-Fall Harvest festival Create your own Fall harvest pumpkin patch on your school grounds to use for storytelling, drawing, photographs, creating Jack-O-Lanterns all while the history of these traditions are discussed.

Potential/Benner's Farm

Fall on the Farm-History and Harvest- Journey through 250 years of farm life, discover how families lived before stores, cars, and electricity, meet farm animals, explore fields and gardens, learn where food comes from, and enjoy a hayride.



Fink's Country Farm

Farm Fall Field Trip- hands-on farm experience featuring hayrides, pumpkin picking, and animal encounters, discover farm life while learning how pumpkins, corn, and other crops grow.

Long Island Game Farm

Animal and Plant Families - Observe how plants and animals grow, change, and share traits with their parents through engaging exploration and discussion.

Fall Pumpkin Picking- A hands-on animal experience, meet and feed a variety of farm animals, including giraffes, kangaroos, camels, lemurs, goats, sheep, cows, alpacas, and more. Learn about wildlife, habitats, and conservation
