- Graduation requirements

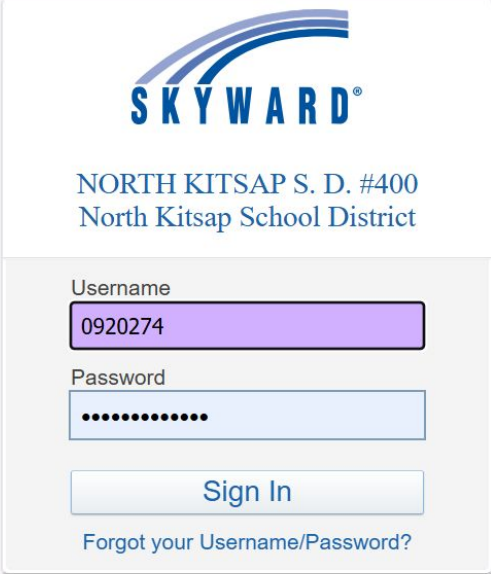
How Students Access Skyward

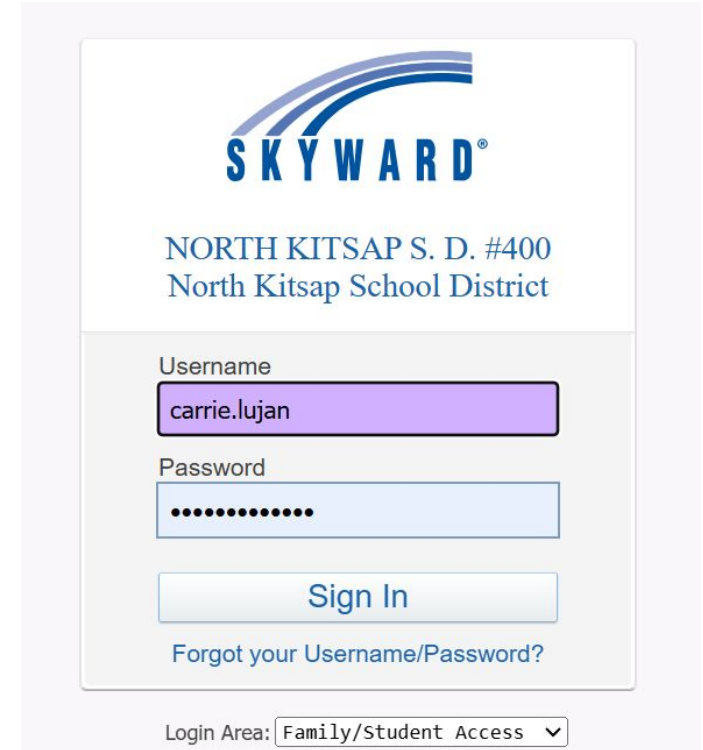

On the left side, click on “Grades”

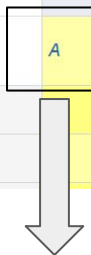
Skyward gives you a snapshot of your student’s academic progress.

Attendance

On the left side, click on “Attendance”

Regular attendance is an important part of student success. Checking Skyward regularly can help families stay informed and address attendance concerns early.

Parents can see:

- Attendance history
- Absences and tardies
- Monitor attendance throughout the year
- Review attendance for specific classes

Graduation Requirements

On the left side, click on “Graduation Requirements”

Students need to earn 24 credits to graduate from high school. Credits are earned by successfully completing required courses. All students will take high school Health and PE in 8th grade. Some students will earn high school math credit in middle school.

Parents can see:

- Completed and attempted credits
- Credits in progress
 - This allows students and families to monitor progress towards graduation
