Purpose of This Meeting:

- Review the revised timeline and work plan.
- Establish a shared understanding of the key questions the data should help answer.
- Review and provide feedback on the districtwide data dashboard and identify any additional data needs.
- Develop a shared understanding of the evaluation framework to be used to assess each region.
- Prepare for the next meeting by identifying trends, questions, and additional information needed after reviewing the districtwide data.

Communication:

On August 24, 2026, the Superintendent Enrollment Planning Advisory Committee (SEPAC) gathered for its fifth meeting. The discussions focused on refining the path forward to ensure responsible, student-centered recommendations for PVSchools' school programming, marketing and communications, and school consolidation and closure. The group remains committed to transparency.

The committee has transitioned to a revised School Consolidation and Closure timeline, which will allow for a more thorough review process. Leadership now expects to present the sub-committee's final recommendation to the Governing Board in November/December 2027 for the 2028- 2029 school year.

The majority of the meeting was attended by the entire SEPAC committee, with members engaging in shared learning and discussion about the data and evaluation structures that will support the School Consolidation and Closure Sub-Committee's work.. The committee was presented with districtwide data including school capacity, enrollment trends, and programming locations. Based on this information, the framework for region evaluation was introduced, ensuring that every recommendation is backed by analytical evidence.

The sub-committees each broke out for the final 30 minutes. School Consolidation and Closure's sub-committee reviewed the data presented and previewed their next steps for the September meeting, while Marketing and Communication finalized their charter and reviewed the draft 2026-2027 outcomes, and School Programming discussed the content and timeline for the sub-committee's future work.
