ACADEMIC PROFILE 2026 - 2027

Liberty High School (LHS), founded in 1891, is a 4-year public high school in the Liberty Public School District. Located in the northeastern suburbs of Kansas City, Liberty is made up of working professionals and businesses. With over 12,500 students, the district includes 11 elementary schools, four middle schools, two high schools, an alternative high school, and an early childhood center.

Graduation Requirements

Students work toward one of three diplomas; Platinum, Gold or Silver. All students are required to earn at least one Market Value Asset (MVA), an experience that prepares students for future learning and/or employment.

Silver: 24 Credits

Gold: 25.5 Credits

Platinum: 28 Credits (2 MVA)

GPA and Class Rank

GPA and class rank are based upon grades 9-12. Seniors are ranked at the completion of semesters 6, 7, and 8. All classes from which a student receives a grade are included in the GPA. The GPA is calculated on a non-weighted, four-point scale. A weighted GPA is provided for college scholarship purposes, but is not included in student class rank.

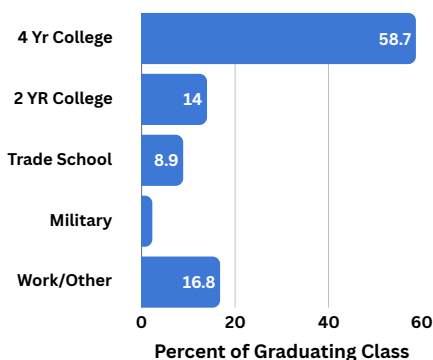

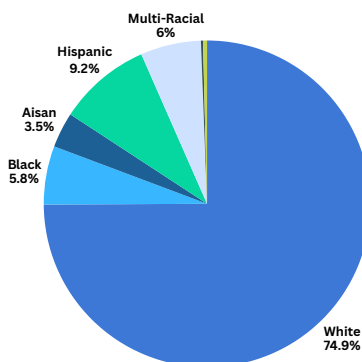
