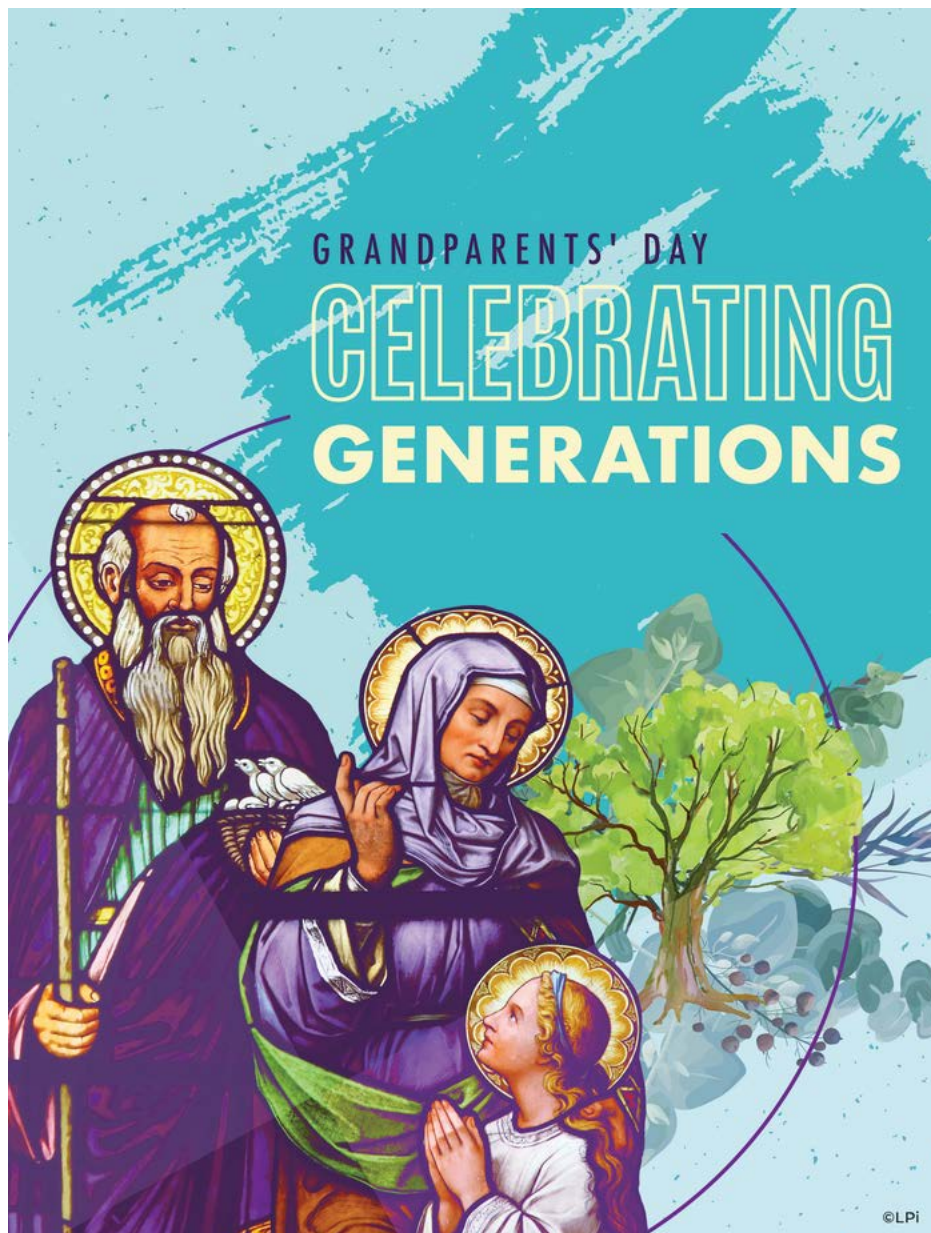

They are often the glue that keeps families together for Thanksgiving, Christmas and Easter family gatherings. They help give us a family identity and often foster the Faith. The patron saints of grandparents are Sts. Anne & Joachim

whose feast day is on July 26th. Sts. Anne and Joachim are the parents of Mother Mary and the grandparents of Jesus. Sts. Anne and Joachim had the special honor of raising Mary to be the right Mother for Jesus and for all of us. Mary, Joseph, and Jesus are the model family, and we can give thanks to God for the role Sts. Anne and Joachim played in supporting the Holy Family.

To those who are grandparents, I encourage you to share the family history, share how wonderful God has been part of your life, and share the Lord's kindness and mercifulness that He has taught and given to you.

To those who have living grandparents, I encourage you to talk with them. Find out your family history, where they grew up, who were their parents, what did they do, what was life like for them, why was the Catholic Faith important to them. I know I always find the conversation interesting when I listen to my last living grandpa who is 97 years old tell me stories about his parents, his Navy days during the Korean War, the importance of the Catholic Faith to him and the family.

For those who no longer have grandparents alive, I encourage you to dig out old photo albums to see what they were like. I also encourage you to visit their gravesite and offer a Rosary for them. These are other ways to stay connected with your grandparents and share the family history with the next generation.

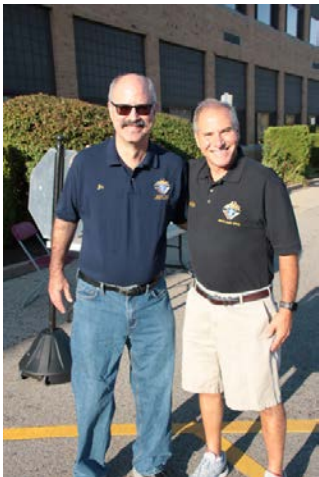

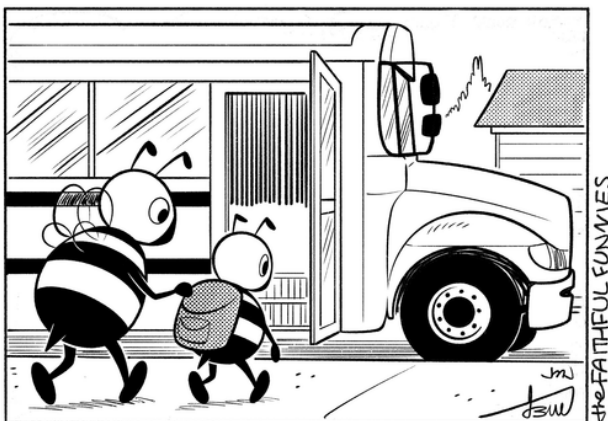
In 2021, Pope Francis established the celebration of the World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly. In the U.S., we observe this celebration in September, joining the Church's efforts to highlight the value and importance of grandparents and the elderly in our families and in society.

While the elderly have traditionally held places of honor in various cultures, today, elderly members of our families and communities often live lives marked by isolation and loneliness. Rather than being a beloved and integral part of a family, they are too often forgotten or overlooked. In the most tragic circumstances, some even seek to end their own lives through assisted suicide so as not to be a burden to their loved ones. Pope Francis has described this shift as a "throwaway culture" in which the weakest are neglected or worse when they are no longer of interest or "use."

As persons made in the image and likeness of God, we possess an infinite dignity that can never be compromised by age or ability. This truth must guide each of us in our responsibility to lovingly accompany those who are in greater need of our time, care, and attention as they face their later years. Such accompaniment is of particular importance as they near the end of their lives, often enduring great sufferings as they prepare for their entrance to eternal life. May each of us joyfully proclaim the Lord's promise to each of us: "I will never forget you" (Isaiah 49:15).

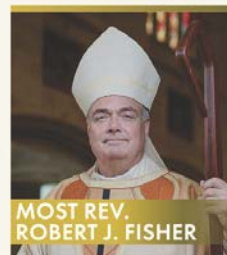

Final words of encouragement

Ultimately, those decisions are to be made after forming one's conscience based on the teachings of the Church and prayerful reflection of candidate positions.

Any claim that Catholics "must" vote for this candidate or that candidate is merely a personal opinion rather than what the Church and the bishops teach the faithful about voting.

Voting as a faithful citizen includes prayer, research, and discernment. It is a thoughtful rather than a reflexive approach.

Remember: All believers are called to be salt, light, and leaven in the world, particularly when they allow the truths of the Catholic faith to form their voting decisions.

In closing, to slightly paraphrase the spiritual motto of St. Padre Pio:

Pray, vote and don't worry.

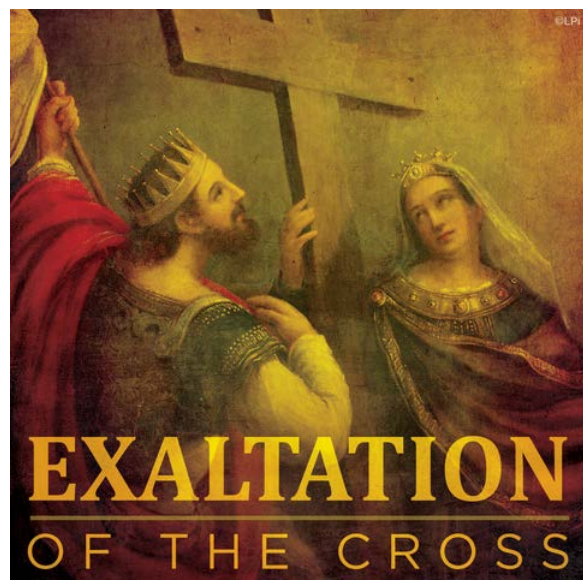

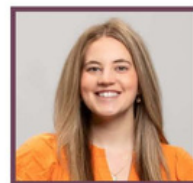

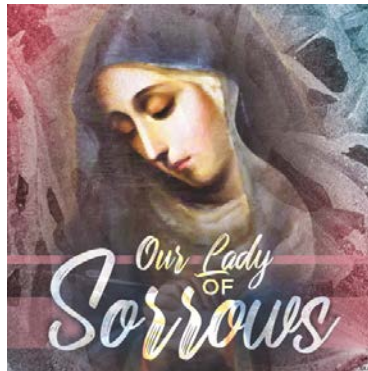
