Dear families,

Online risks are constantly evolving, and staying informed is critical to keeping our students safe. Our district, along with several neighboring Green Bay area districts, is co-hosting a vital community presentation event titled [Digital Safety & The Dangers of Sextortion](#) on Monday, October 5, 2026, at 5:30 PM at the Ashwaubenon PAC.

This presentation features [John DeMay](#), who will share his family's story following the tragic online exploitation of his son, Jordan. Together with local experts, the event will cover how to recognize early warning signs, understand predator tactics, and utilize practical tools to protect youth online.

Local community agencies and school districts will be available afterward to share resources.

Please note: Due to the sensitive nature of this topic, it is recommended that children under 6th grade do not attend. Older students should attend with an adult.

School Year Policies

Student leaving early for the day?

You may now use fxattendance@depere.k12.wi.us to contact the office regarding a student absence and/or an upcoming appointment.

For students leaving early for an appointment, please send them with a note. They can then get a pass from their teacher or the office to be excused at the time you request. They will then meet you in the foyer where you will sign them out on the iPad.

Pick-up and Drop-off Safety and Etiquette Guidelines:

- Enter at the North Michigan St entrance (Near Merrill St.) and pull ALL the way forward to the south end in a single-file line; do not block the crosswalk
- Do not block the sidewalk or bus entrance when entering the parking lane. If it is full, pull past the entrance and use Michigan St for pick up, or go around the block until the area is clear
- NEVER park, stop, or stand between Merrill and the pick-up lane entrance on Michigan St. This area is striped white and is posted no parking.
- Do NOT enter at the south entrance (Bolles/Michigan intersection)
- All cars should remain off of the playground area until the last bus loads students at 3:15 PM
- If you are at Foxview to pick up your child between 2:30 - 2:55 PM, use Michigan St. If you end up in the pick-up line, do NOT leave your car. Instead, call the office and we will send your child to you.
- After you pick up your child, use the lane nearest the fence area to pull out and around remaining cars in the pick-up line.
- When cars are leaving the pick-up line, please continue to pull forward to allow others to enter.
- Be cautious, aware of pedestrians, and PATIENT when using the pick-up lane.
