I hereby order all flags flown in the State of Montana to be flown at half-staff on Friday, September 11, 2026, from sunrise to sunset in memory of the innocent lives lost in the terrorist attacks of September 11, 2001, and in honor of all who answered the call to protect and defend the United States against terrorism.

Furthermore, I ask all Montanans to observe a statewide moment of silence beginning at 6:46 a.m. Mountain Daylight Time to remember the moment the first plane struck the World Trade Center and to honor the 25th anniversary of this solemn day.
