Faith & Values

- Does our family share OCA's Christian faith and values, per the OCA Statement of Faith?
- Are we looking for a school that actively anchors all they do in Jesus, not just Bible class?
- Are we ready to partner with the school in shepherding our student's walk with Christ?



Academic & Developmental Readiness



- Is my student generally tracking at or above academic grade level?
- Can my student function respectfully and autonomously in a classroom setting, respective to their age?
- Are we aligned with a Montessori, hands-on learning model, unique to many traditional classrooms?

Financial Fit



- Can our family comfortably afford the net cost of tuition and fees?
- Do we understand our available NC state aid options?

Schedule & Logistics



- Is OCA's location and schedule realistic for our family's day-to-day rhythm?
- Can we reliably manage transportation to and from school and activities?
