- The PSAT will be given on Friday, October 16 at 8:35 a.m. in C30. The PSAT is an opportunity to practice for future college entrance testing and is the first step for juniors who want to be considered for the National Merit Scholarship Program. Students in 10th and 11th grade who are strong in reading, writing, and math—or who want to challenge themselves and get a feel for the PSAT—should consider taking it. The cost of the test is \$18 and can be paid through SchoolPay. Sign up in the Counseling Office by September 23. If you have questions, see Ms. Eider in the Counseling Office.
