GETTING YOUR STUDENT SIGNED IN

- 1 On the iPad dock, tap **Clever** — a white **C** on a blue square.
- 2 When Clever asks for the badge, hold your student's **badge page** up to the iPad camera.
- 3 Choose **Imagine Learning Virtual Portal** — the navy square with light-blue figures.
- 4 Your student **sets their own PIN** the first time. There is no password sent home.
- 5 From then on, GRAVA courses open through that portal — **Buzz** for K–5 and **Edgenuity** for 6–12.

Not using a district iPad?

Plenty of students work from a home computer, laptop, or their own tablet. On any device, go to clever.com/login — your student can sign in there with the same Clever badge from their handout. The rest of the steps are the same.

Already set your PIN? Your student can also go straight to the portal at ilvp.imaginelearning.com.

Once your student is signed in, the guardian account below lets you follow their progress right alongside them.

MONITOR PROGRESS WITH A GUARDIAN ACCOUNT

Parents and guardians can:

- Create guardian accounts to track student progress
- View and send communications
- Communicate with teachers
- Review grades
- See student attendance minutes

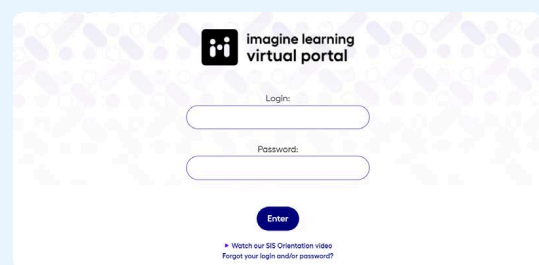
The guardian portal looks just like your student's portal, but assignments can only be submitted in the student's.

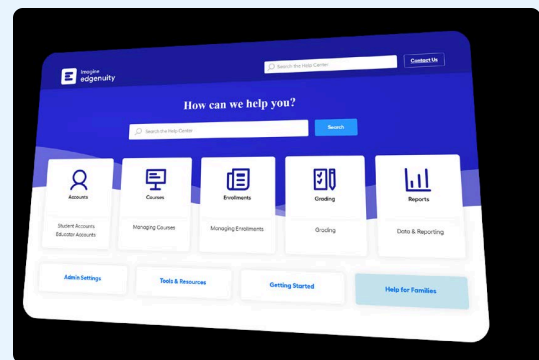

Inside the guardian portal

— and how to help at home

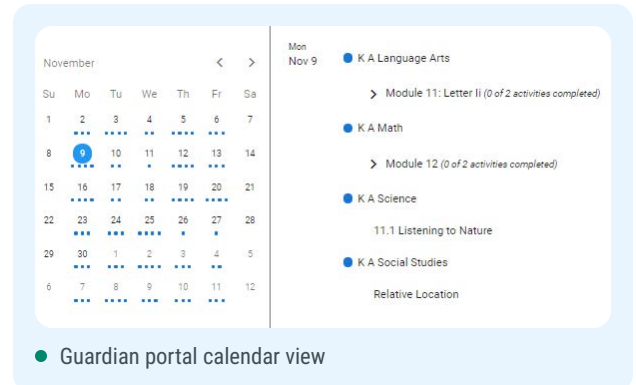


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Within the guardian portal, you'll be able to track your student's progress using the **to-do list** and **calendar**.

The **to-do list** shows upcoming or past-due activities within seven days. This list will be empty if your student is more than seven days ahead in their courses. If an activity displays **past due**, then your student is behind.

In the **calendar** view, you'll find color-coded due dates by course — choose a date to see what is due that day. You can view a selection of courses at a time and adjust the amount of work displayed by day, week, or month.



How to help your student learn at home

- Choose a comfortable, distraction-free space as a work area for your student.
- Create a plan, such as "focus time" and "break time," to help them connect and succeed.
- Make sure your student has Wi-Fi and a charged device, such as a laptop, tablet, or smartphone.
- Show interest in what your student is learning about with questions like, "What did your learning focus on today?" or "What questions do you have about the lesson?"

Stay connected to your student's teacher

Regularly checking in with your student's teacher can help your student succeed. Teachers can be reached by email, by phone, during regular office hours, or by booking an appointment* with them outside of office hours.

Reach out to the teacher if you have any questions about the course or assignments, or if your student is:

- Having a hard time understanding a concept
- Falling behind in assignments
- Finding the work too easy and lacking challenge
