Student Absences - IMPORTANT CHANGES for the 2026-27 School Year!!

As of 2026 school year, the Marysville Exempted Village School District no longer utilizes the same attendance protocol. There is a new way to report your students absences, and there are a couple of ways that a parent can access it.

Helpful Hints:

- If you have more than one student please make sure you are on the correct students PowerHub- You can change your student on the upper left hand side of your PowerHub
- Please be sure to have your student's school ID number available when setting up your account. You can access your child's 5-digit student ID number via your PowerSchool Parent Portal account.
- A PaySchools Central app on the registration page is available as well for your convenience.



If your student is going to be absent from school, please contact the **attendance reporting line** at **(855) 876-7974** and follow the automated prompts.

You can also report your student's absence online by going to your **PowerSchool Parent Account** and clicking on the **MyPowerHub** tab where the **SafeArrival Link** will allow you to report an absence for your student.

★ Students going home different than their “Normal Procedure”

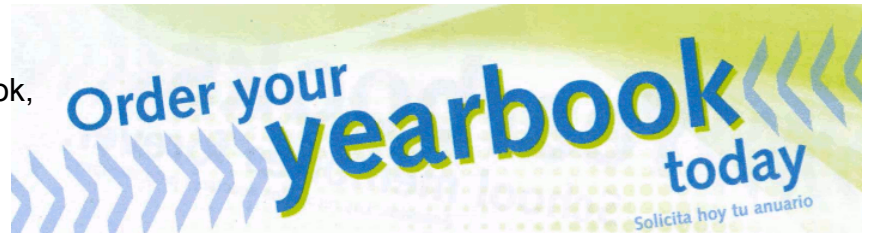

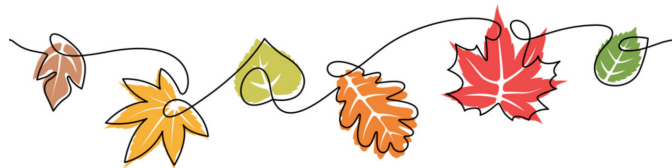

Marysville Youth Mobility & Safety Guide:



Keeping our students safe is a shared community priority. In partnership with the Marysville Police Division, we are sharing the official **Marysville Youth Mobility & Safety Guide** to help families understand key local laws and promote safe riding habits.

Under Marysville city regulations, parents and guardians are legally responsible for ensuring their children understand and follow local mobility laws. Please review these critical regulations with your student:

- **Mandatory Helmet Laws:** Helmets are legally required for all riders under 16 (and under 18 for mopeds, EPAMDs, or Class 3 E-bikes).
- **Speed & Night Equipment Limits:** Sidewalk riding is capped at 10 mph. Riding after dark requires a white front headlight (visible up to 500 ft) and a red rear light or reflector.
- **Uptown "No Ride" Zone:** Bicycles, e-bikes, scooters, skateboards, and rollerblades are strictly prohibited on sidewalks within one block of 5th & Main Street.
- **E-Bike Sidewalk Rules:** Class 1 and Class 2 E-bikes must have their motors turned completely off if operated on any sidewalk.

Thank you for discussing these legally binding safety rules with your children so we can keep our streets and sidewalks safe for everyone.

If you have not submitted your required "Back to School" information via your PowerSchool Parent Portal, please log in to your parent account and complete them now. It is important that we have updated information for each of our students in the event of an emergency.

If you are unable to access your PowerSchool Parent Portal, you can utilize the "Forgot Username or Password" option. If needed, you can contact your student's school office (Creekview : 937-578-6600), for help accessing your account. If you have the PowerSchool App on your phone/tablet, you will need to utilize a computer or web browser on your phone/tablet as the App will not allow you to gain access to the required forms.
