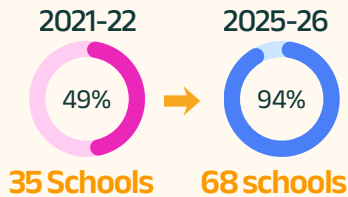

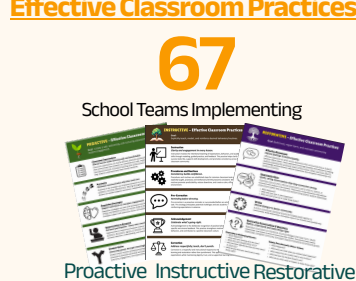

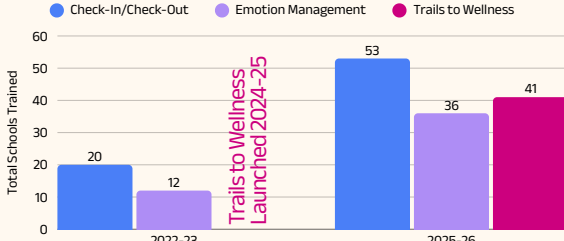

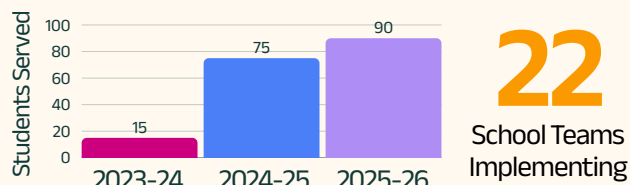

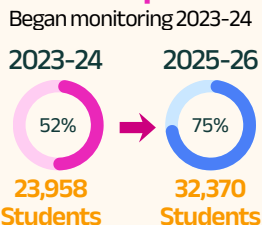

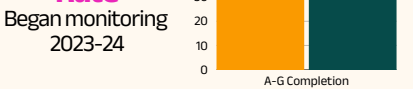

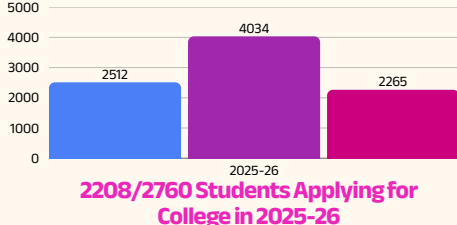

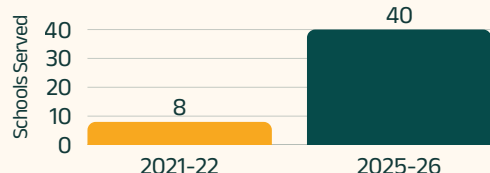

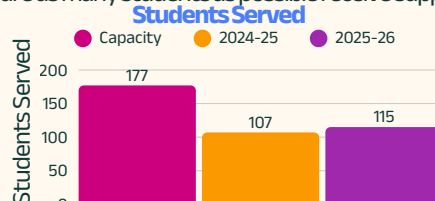

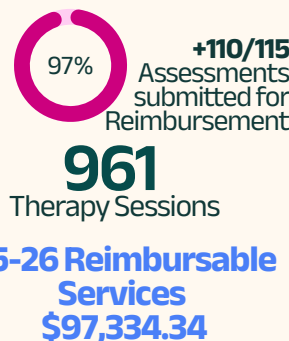

School Nurses create an Annual Calendar of IEP's, screenings, vision events, dental events to support the wellness of their students.

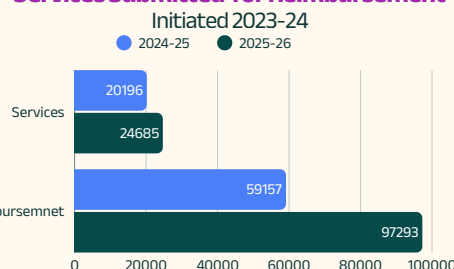
Eyeglasses Distributed at On-Campus Vision Events

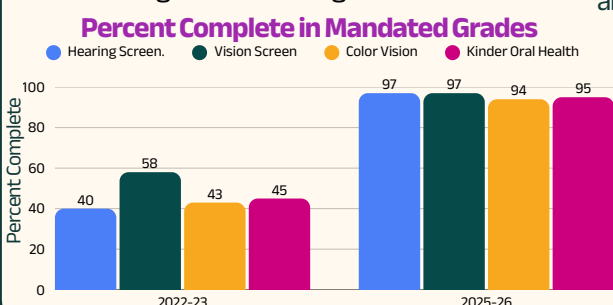

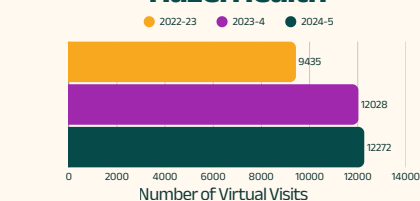

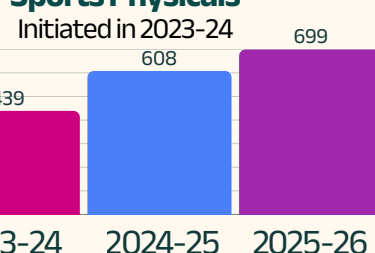

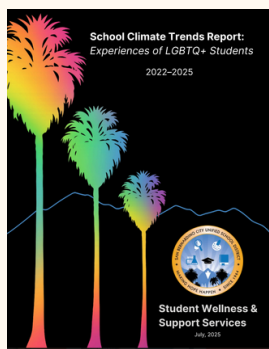

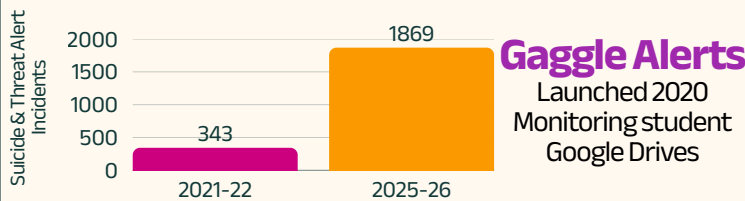
