Thank you to all who joined us for the 9/11 Patriot's Day ceremony this morning. This was a special time to honor those who lost their lives twenty-five years ago on this day. We remember them and we can carry on their legacy of courage, kindness and hope.

As we look ahead to the rest of the month, please note a few upcoming schedule reminders. Believe it or not, we are already almost halfway through the first trimester! The steady momentum across our classrooms was built on the foundation we set during Smart Start. Having those early individual appointments gave our teachers clear, actionable insights into each child's unique strengths and learning needs from day one. **The time we invested upfront has allowed us to launch Reading Intervention 5 weeks earlier than in years past!** Students receiving reading intervention for 30 minutes daily gained an incredible 750 additional minutes of targeted reading support this school year!

- **Tailored Enrichment:** We identified students who are ready for deeper academic challenges in math and reading but do not yet qualify for pull-out gifted services. In response, our classroom teachers can now collaborate weekly with our Gifted Intervention Specialist to design engaging extension activities.
- **Growth for Every Learner:** Even for students who do not require extra intervention or specialized enrichment, Smart Start ensures that daily classroom instruction is precisely calibrated to their baseline skills, allowing teachers to maximize growth and engagement for all children.

By tailoring our instruction to meet students where they are, we ensure that personalized learning isn't just an ideal, but a daily standard that drives academic excellence across our entire school community. Thank you for your continued partnership as we work together to help every student reach their full potential.
