Op-con A /Visine/Visine AC	OS/OD or OU as appropriate	1-2 drops in the affected eye(s) [not for use w/ contact lenses]	Q6 hr PRN for itchy/allergy/red eyes		
Anbesol, Orajel, Orabase, ST37, oral pain reliever	Apply to affected area of gums or oral mucosa	Per label instructions	As needed for oral pain		
(Medikoff) Cough Drops	PO (orally) Throat lozenges	1 lozenge	Q 2hrs PRN or as directed by doctor for cough or sore throat		
Mineral Ice/Icy Hot (NMS & NHS)	Apply topically to affected muscles	Per label instructions	As needed for muscle aches & pains
