01

Attend

Send your student to school when they are fever-free, diarrhea-free or are not vomiting for 24 hours. Students should not miss more than 10% of school at any time.

02

Contact

Contact the front office if your student will be out sick or you will be out of town.

03

Independent Study

If your child misses 3 or more days of school in a row, sign up for Short-Term Independent Study and make up the work. This will clear their absences (up to 15 per year).

04

Connect

Connect early and often with the school if you are having trouble getting your child to school. We may have resources to help.

What is Chronic Absenteeism?

- A student is chronically absent if they miss more than 10% of the school year (e.g., 6 out of 50 days).
- Chronic absenteeism is tracked weekly at the district level and monitored federally.
- Schools must notify parents when their student is chronically absent.
- Students can complete up to 15 days of Short-Term Independent Study per year to regain credit for missed days.
- Short-Term Independent Study can be done after an illness.

What is truancy?

- Truancy occurs when a student has 3 or more unexcused absences.
- Families of truant or chronically absent students must attend a School Attendance Review Team (SART) meeting.
