- ▶ Someone is being bullied.
- ▶ Someone brought a weapon to school or is talking about it.
- ▶ A person or property is in danger.
- ▶ Someone is hurting a person.
- ▶ Someone is hurting animals.
- ▶ Someone is posting mean things online.
- ▶ Something that makes you feel unsafe or uncomfortable.

- ▶ When do jokes stop being funny and start being mean?
- ▶ We **never** tease someone about anything that is part of who they are as a person.
 - ▶ Race or Ethnic Background

 - ▶ Disability
 - ▶ Body type or physical features
