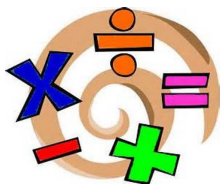


The 2026-2027 After-School Activities are Ready to Set Sail!



The Voyage Program has returned to Foxview along with Intramurals (see below for Intramural details). Voyage is intended to give students an opportunity to participate in an array of before and after-school activities. Foxview teachers and staff create unique classes that express their interests and generously offer their expertise to our students! Registration Procedures

Please complete the online registration form. **Registration is open (via link provided) and will stay open through September 27th.** Placement in classes with limited enrollment will be randomly selected from all the registration responses. Students should identify up to three possible options to have the best chance of being assigned an activity. In order to offer as many students an opportunity to participate, students can choose 1 Voyage activity and 1 Intramural activity; additional Intramural or Voyage courses will be assigned if there is room on the roster.

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Additional Extracurricular Activities

In addition to Voyage and Intramurals, we offer a number of additional extracurricular activities. Some activities are by nomination or performance-based. **Look for information on sign-up in the Parent Communication throughout the year.**

Destination Imagination - DI is a project-based learning program where teams of students work to solve various challenges. Students learn the creative process from **imagination** to innovation and the skills needed to thrive in school, their careers, and beyond. A significant time commitment is necessary to participate, as teams meet once a week (or more) from November through March.



Running Club – Competitive cross-country races with local area schools. Sept-Oct. IN PROGRESS



Hope Squad - 6th grade students who are trained to watch for at-risk students and provide friendship, identify warning signs, and seek help from adults. Nomination-based.

Battle of the Books – Battle of the Books is a voluntary reading competition for teams of 3 to 4 students. The students read books on a book list and compete against other teams to see who is able to answer more questions correctly about the books. Sign up in October/November - Battle in February.

Jazz Band – The jazz band is an after-school extension of Band and gives the 6th grade band students an opportunity to play different styles of jazz music, such as blues, swing, Latin, and rock. Meets Tuesdays and Thursdays after school. *PLEASE NOTE: Jazz Band is by invitation only, based on skill level and experience.*



Student Ambassador Team– 5th and 6th Grade students serve as ambassadors to new students, as well as tour guides for parent orientation and 4th grade visits. Students will be selected from teacher recommendations and interest. *Additional information will be distributed in January.*



BADL Basketball– Organized by Booster Clubs; parent volunteers are appreciated.

Wrestling (6th Grade) – Teamed with the middle school students, competitive wrestling travels to schools in the area to compete. Dec-March

Foxview Play/Musical -Newsies Jr. will be presented in 2027. Watch for details beginning in December.

Forensics – Forensics is a wonderful way for 6th grade students to build knowledge, confidence, and an interest in speaking through the use of plays, acting, drama, storytelling, poetry, reporting, or demonstration speeches.
