

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

By and between
LTUSD and STEA
November 6, 2025

The Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP) is a three-year plan that describes the goals, actions, services, and expenditures to support positive student outcomes that address state and local priorities. The LCAP provides an opportunity for local educational agencies (LEAs) to share their stories of how, what, and why programs and services are selected to meet their local needs. The LCAP is a tool for our District to set goals, plan actions, and leverage resources to meet those goals to improve student outcomes. The District agrees that STEA (South Tahoe Educators' Association) is the exclusive representative of the certificated employees and has the right to consult, provide feedback and recommendations on LCAP goals and actions.

In alignment with the focus on stakeholder engagement the parties agree the following procedures shall be used:

The parties shall jointly manage the LCAPAC (Local Control and Accountability Plan Advisory Committee).

1. The committee shall be composed of the following members:
 - a. The District members shall be the Superintendent or designee, one Principal from each site, and a District representative from Student Services, Multilingual Learner Equity, and Business Services.
 - b. The STEA Association members shall be the Association President or designee, one Association member from each school site, and one Association member from Mt. Tallac Continuation High School, Al Tahoe Learning Center, and Special Services, respectively, chosen by the STEA.
 - c. An additional teacher from each site, chosen by the Principal.
 - d. The CSEA President or designee.
 - e. 1-2 South Tahoe High School students chosen by the Superintendent or Principal
2. The committee shall meet three times each year, starting in November of each school year.
3. The committee shall review current and proposed goals, actions, services, expenditures and provide feedback and recommend modifications, adjustments, or changes to LCAP goals and actions.

Note: This memorandum of understanding replaces MOU dated July 16, 2021 regarding the CCSSAC.
