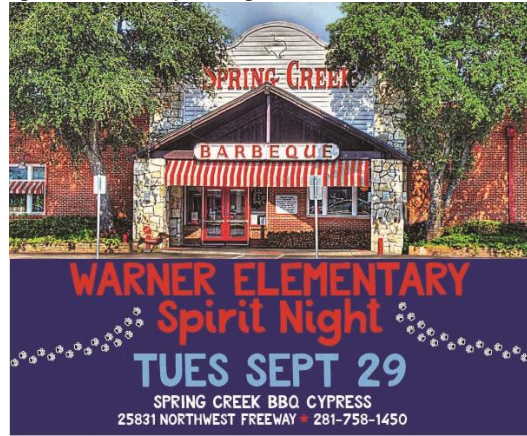

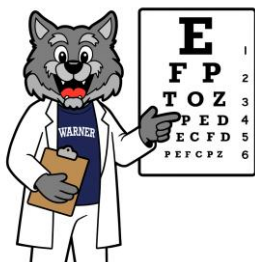

Hearing and Vision Screening



Hearing and Vision Screening will be done on all Warner Students **Tuesday, September 29, 2026 and Wednesday, September 30, 2026.**

Scoliosis/Kyphosis Screening for 5th Grade Students

The nurse will be conducting spinal screening on 5th grade female students per CFISD protocol. All children who attend public or private school must be screened in accordance to the following schedule: Girls will be screened two times, once at age 10 (or Fall Semester of Grade 5) and again at age 12 (or Fall Semester of Grade 7). Boys will be screened one time at age 13 or 14 (or Fall Semester of Grade 8). The purpose of spinal screening is to detect the signs of abnormal curves of the spine at their earliest stages so that the need for treatment can be determined. Scoliosis, a common spinal abnormality found in adolescents, is a sideways twisting of the spine. It is usually detected in children between 10 and 14 years of age. Kyphosis, sometimes called round back, is an exaggerated rounding of the upper back and is often confused with poor posture. Many cases of curvature of the spine are mild and require only ongoing observation by a physician when they are first diagnosed. Others can worsen with time as the child grows and require active treatment such as bracing and surgery. Early treatment can prevent the development of a severe deformity, which can affect a person's appearance and health. The procedure for screening is simple. Screeners who have been specially trained will look at your child's back while he/she stands and then bends forward. Parents will be notified of the results of the screening only if professional follow-up is necessary. This screening procedure does not replace your child's need for regular health care and checkup. According to state law, all students in the grades listed above must receive the spinal screening. If, for religious reasons, you do not wish to have your child screened, you are to submit an affidavit of religious exemption to the school nurse, Herlinda Smith, no later than **Monday, September 21, 2026.**

Dress Code and Grooming Guidelines



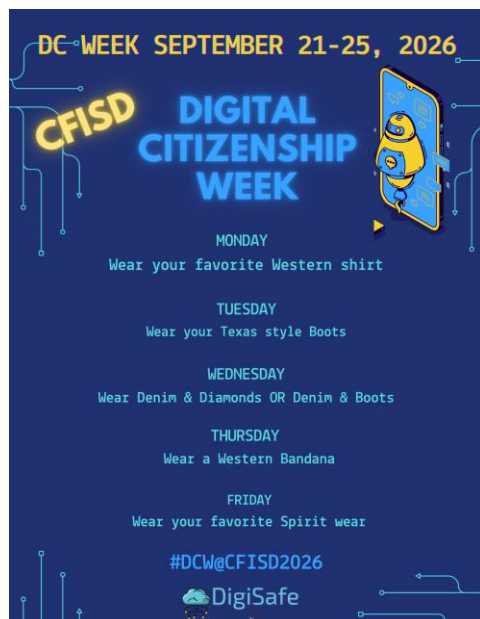
We want to remind you of the district's dress code and grooming guidelines. Most of the time, students come to school in compliance with the dress code. When violations occur, it is usually the result of the children outgrowing their clothing or too many washings and dryings (causing the clothes to shrink and become too short).

- Bottoms must fit at the waist or upper hip, must not reveal underclothing, and must be mid-thigh in length or longer.
- Tops must not reveal underclothing midsection, torso or back.
- Shoes must not detract from or interfere with the learning environment or present a safety or health hazard. Tennis shoes or closed-toe shoes are preferred. House shoes/house slippers of any kind are not allowed.
- ID Badges are part of the Student Dress Code. The badges and the unique student number will be used to account for students utilizing transportation services, checking out library books and purchasing food items from the cafeteria, providing a means for easy identification of students in common areas of the school and for other uses as determined by campus administration. All Warner students shall wear a student ID badge, visible, on the school-approved lanyards during the instructional day.
