

# RESD Bus Rules



1. The driver is in charge of all passengers. Students must sit in assigned seats unless otherwise directed by the driver. The driver must give permission for windows to be opened.
2. School rules apply while riding a school bus. Everyone will be quiet at railroad crossings, pockets on the seat at all times and hands must stay in the bus.
3. Eating or drinking on the bus to and from school is not allowed. Please keep your bus clean.
4. Changing your stop or bus requires a bus pass. You need written permission from parents/guardians and must obtain a bus pass from a school office. When walking to bus stops, always face traffic – cross in front of the bus when the driver gives a signal. Never cross behind the bus. Use appropriate conduct while waiting at the bus stop.
5. Wear your seatbelt if provided. Use emergency exits when instructed by the driver. Keep aisles and doors clear for emergencies at all times.
6. You may use your personal electronic device if you:
  - A. keep your device to yourself, no sharing of devices or content.
  - B. refrain from taking photos/videos or sharing photos/videos via Apps.
  - C. listen to music with one ear bud so you can hear the driver.
  - D. put it away immediately if requested by the driver.
  - E. make emergency phone calls only.
7. Prohibited items: glass containers, large, heavy, bulky, sharp items, lighters, vapor devices, e-cigarettes, tobacco, weapons, animals, aerosols, drugs and alcohol. Any damage to the bus will be charged to you and your parents. **Riding the bus is a privilege you can lose.**
