This intensive one-day workshop will guide students through the entire college essay writing process—from exploring possible topics and generating ideas to drafting, receiving feedback, revising, and developing a polished final draft. Students will work with experienced instructors and peers to discover the experiences, stories, and perspectives that can make their essays meaningful and memorable.

Students will leave the workshop with a developing college essay draft that, with additional polishing, can be used for college or scholarship applications this year.

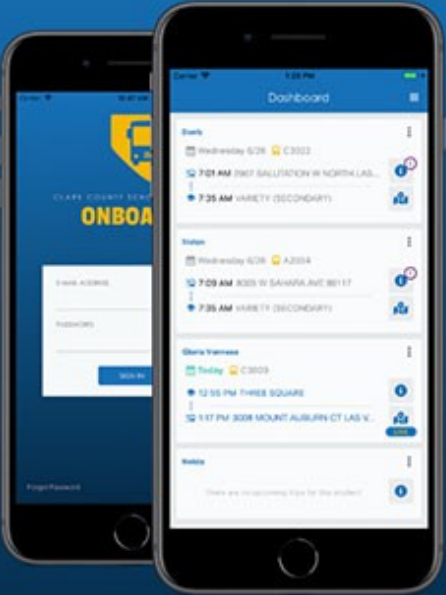
