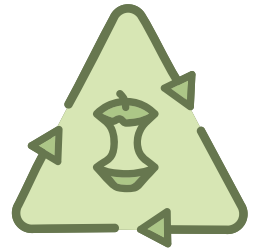




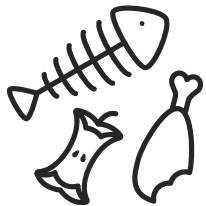
Food Scrap Drop-off Program

Download the MetroKEY app.
Register for a free account.

Separate food scraps. Scraps can be put in loose. BPI certified compostable bags and brown paper bags are OK to use. Do NOT use plastic bags.

Deposit scraps at a drop-off station. Food scraps are sent to Quantum Biopower in Southington and turned into bio-power (electricity) and compost!
