1. During the 2026–2027 school year, Mahwah Public Schools will successfully engage in the New Jersey Quality Single Accountability Continuum (NJQSAC) review process as an opportunity to evaluate and strengthen district systems, practices, and outcomes. Through a collaborative and evidence-based process, district and school leadership will assess current practices across the five NJQSAC areas: Instruction and Program, Fiscal Management, Governance, Operations, and Personnel, to ensure compliance with state requirements while identifying opportunities for continuous improvement.
2. During the 2026–2027 school year, Mahwah Township Public Schools will build educator knowledge, confidence, and capacity regarding the responsible and purposeful use of artificial intelligence in education. Through differentiated professional learning, collaborative exploration, and ongoing support, all educators will develop a foundational understanding of AI, explore its potential to enhance teaching, learning, differentiation, productivity, and student engagement, and understand the safeguards necessary for its safe, ethical, and effective use.
3. During the 2026–2027 school year, the district will engage administrators, educators, and appropriate support staff in a comprehensive process to research, learn, and identify best practices for developing students’ executive functioning skills across grades K–12. Through collaborative study, review of current practices, and identification of developmentally appropriate student needs, the district will create a K–12 Executive Functioning Skills Framework and Progression by the end of the 2026–2027 school year. The framework will identify priority skills, evidence-based instructional practices, and appropriate supports at each grade level or developmental band, establishing a consistent districtwide approach and preparing for implementation beginning in the 2027–2028 school year.
