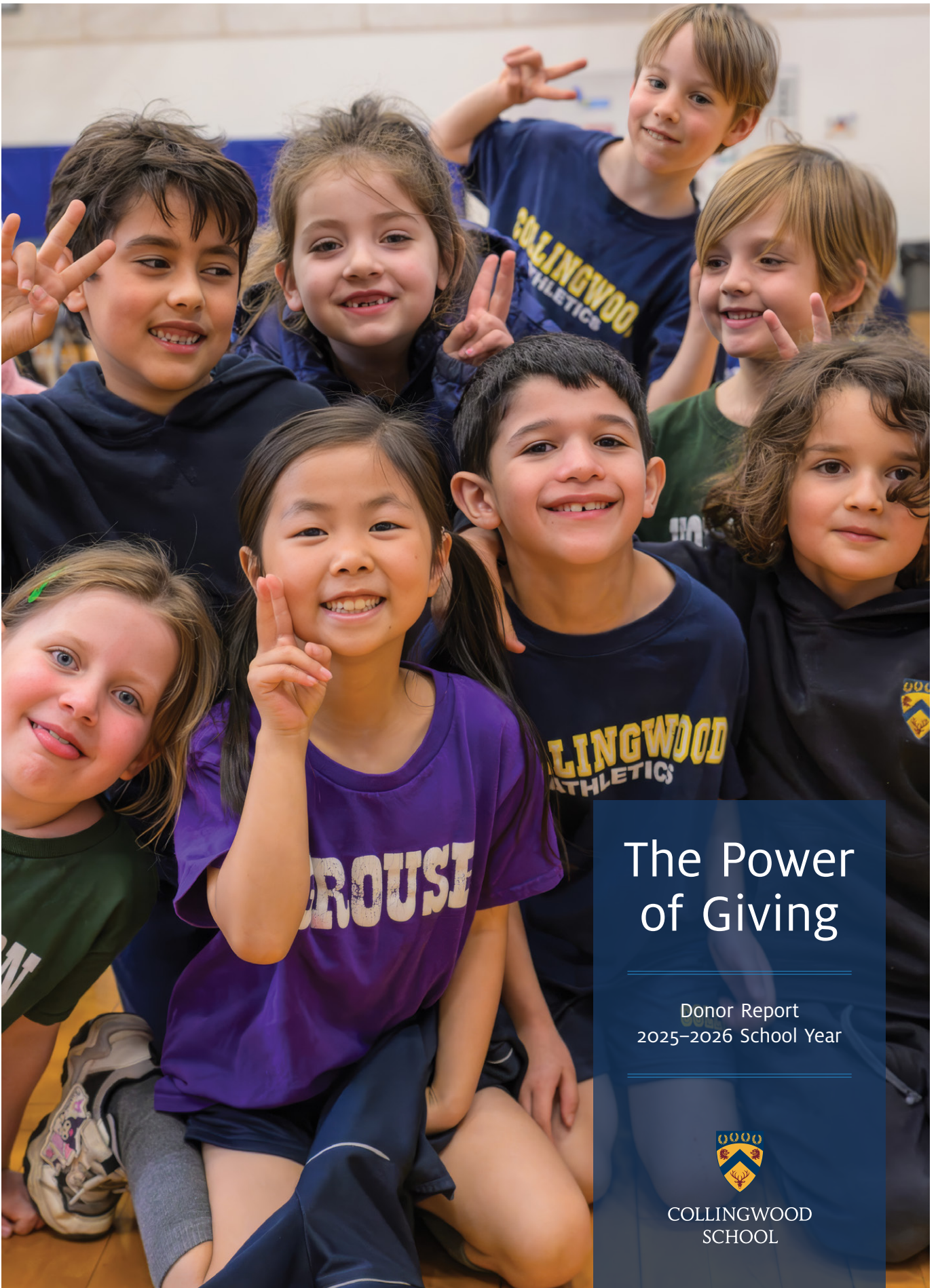

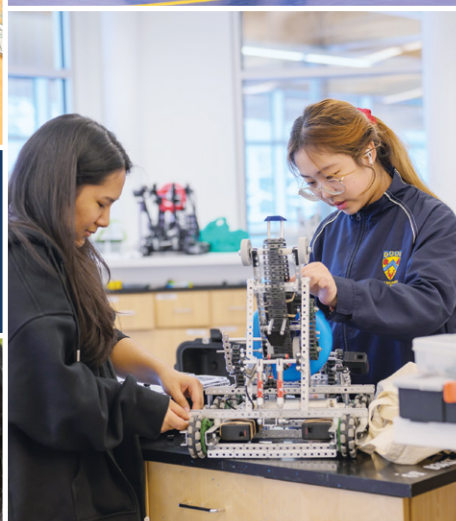

EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING

Thanks to the Tartan Fund, students have access to many real-world learning experiences, such as a Gr. 9 sailing course offered in H-Block. Through hands-on instruction, students had the chance to develop their sailing, navigation and water-safety skills. Students earned their CANSail 1 certification (Canada's national learn-to-sail program).

Lisa Evans Scholarship

A legacy taking shape

We are extremely excited to have launched the Lisa Evans Scholarship this year. Created to honour Lisa and the values she has lived throughout her many years at Collingwood, the scholarship embodies her integrity, empathy and belief that a Collingwood education will inspire meaningful lives for our students.

Established as an endowed scholarship, the Lisa Evans Scholarship will support one deserving student entering Gr. 8–10 who demonstrates integrity, empathy and purpose. This scholarship also reflects an important priority for us. As we look to our future, we will continue to ensure that Collingwood is accessible to a wide range of students whose contributions support overall excellence at our School.

The response from Collingwood's school community has been both generous and heartfelt. With \$420,000 committed to date, the Lisa Evans Scholarship is well on its way toward the long-term endowment goal of \$500,000, which would provide approximately \$17,500 in scholarship support each year. The inaugural Lisa Evans Scholarship recipient will be selected during the 2026–27 school year, with the scholarship supporting the student beginning in 2027–28.

With Lisa continuing as Head of School through the coming year, the scholarship remains an active and meaningful opportunity for our community to honour her leadership while helping shape Collingwood's future.

Zhu & Song Family Outdoor Classroom

A new space for experiential learning

This year marked the successful completion of the fundraising campaign for the Zhu & Song Outdoor Classroom, a purposeful new environment designed to expand experiential learning at the Junior School.



Made possible through the generosity of Collingwood families, the Zhu & Song Outdoor Classroom reflects a shared belief in the value of learning environments that broaden how students engage, explore and connect. The generosity of a small group of families helped move the project forward in time for summer construction, ensuring it is ready for the start of the 2026–27 school year.

Designed for use by every student from JK to Gr. 7, the Zhu & Song Outdoor Classroom supports outdoor instruction, small-group learning, observation, discussion and reflection. It will support hands-on learning across the curriculum, while also serving as an important gathering place for Gr. 6 and 7 students at recess and lunch.

“The Zhu & Song Outdoor Classroom is so much more than just an additional classroom, said Junior School Principal Marc Young, “it expands how our students learn, gather and connect. From JK to Gr. 7, it will support meaningful outdoor learning across the curriculum, while also giving our older Junior School students an important place to come together as part of daily life at Wentworth.”

Project Excellence

Year Two: A lasting impact on teaching and learning

Made possible by the generosity of the Collingwood community, the STEEM Centre and Learning Commons enter their second school year as a fully integrated part of the daily school life of Morven students.

“In year two, what stands out most is how naturally these spaces have become part of teaching and learning at Collingwood,” said Senior School Principal Martin Jones. “The STEEM Centre and Learning Commons are active, flexible environments where students are thinking more independently, collaborating more intentionally, and engaging more deeply in their learning.”

The STEEM Centre has become a true hub for entrepreneurship, design and innovation, with 80+ students using the space



each Wednesday morning and additional student groups gathering there throughout the week for competitions, student publications and collaborative projects. The Learning Commons has also matured into an essential student-centred environment that is now in constant use throughout the day, supporting formal instruction, research, collaboration and self-directed learning.

Together, these spaces continue to reflect the lasting impact of community generosity on teaching and learning.

For Athena and James Kondopulos, supporting Collingwood is a way to express the gratitude they have felt since joining the school community in 2016. For their three children (Kallea, Gr. 6; Demetre, Gr. 8; and Evalena, Gr. 9), the School has become much more than just a place of learning. They believe Collingwood is helping to shape their children's education, character and confidence, while also providing a strong sense of belonging.
