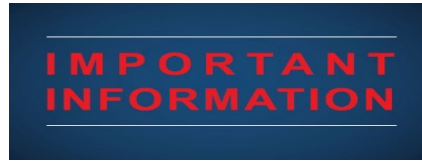

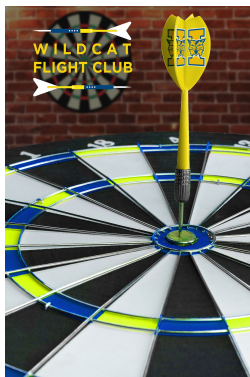
\$100,000 Challenge
