It is administered to high school students, post-secondary students, and military applicants, and is required for anyone seeking to enlist in the U.S. Armed Forces

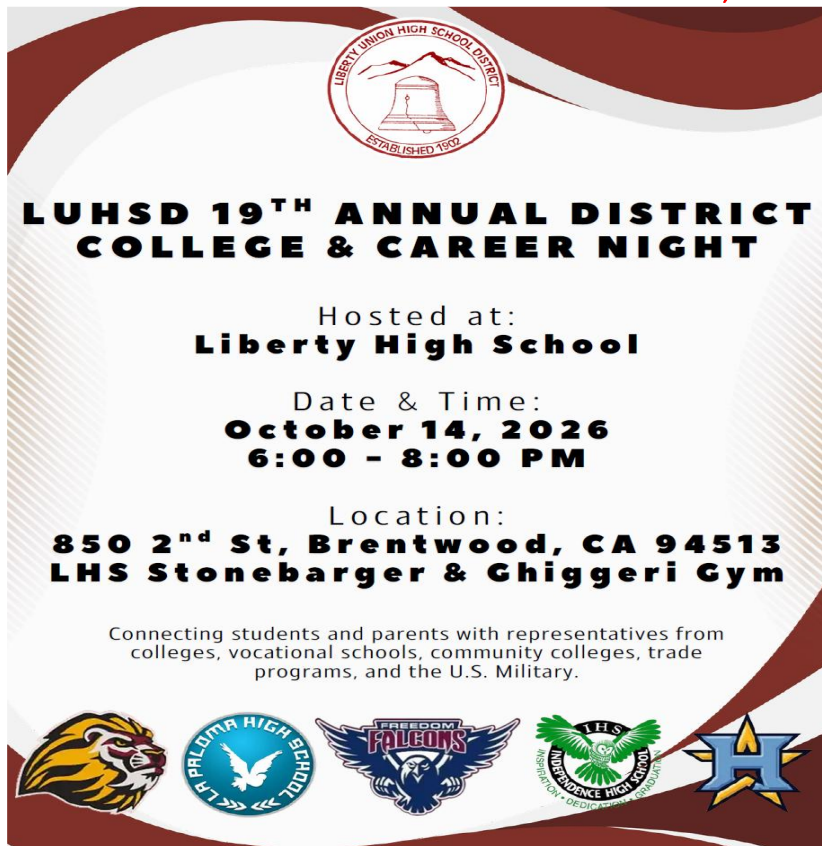
